They shall immediately act and respond to all reported illegal forest activities and other environmental issues and concerns.

They shall conduct surveillance operation and apprehend illegally sourced lumber/timber and other forest products including conveyances, implements and tools and equipment used, gather evidence and other vital information for the filing of case in court against the perpetrators and/or violators.

They shall closely coordinate with the barangay / municipal local government units and other law enforcement agencies for assistance and security purposes.

The team shall submit spot report within 36 hours of any incident investigated and monthly accomplishment report every end of the month for further evaluation and appropriate action.

This Order takes effect immediately and shall remain enforce until revoked in writing by the undersigned and/or higher authorities.

They shall report immediately and assume the duties and responsibilities attached to their positions/designations and maintain appropriate coordination with the LGU's and other law enforcement government agencies concerning environmental and natural resources protection.

The field personnel shall conduct regular foot patrolling activities to their respective area of jurisdiction following the schedule submitted by their respective Team Leader and shall keep daily record of their activities in the performance of their duties. Manned their respective station on 24/7 and submit monthly accomplishment report and Checkpoint Monthly Monitoring Report (CMMR) including issues and concerns encountered. Maintain logbook for their attendance and record all forest products / items passing thru the stations.

They shall clear themselves of all works, property and financial accountabilities in their present station before reporting to their new assignment. They shall inform the undersigned in writing of their compliance with this Order for record purposes.

They shall perform other functions as may be assigned to them.

This Order take effect immediately and shall remain until revoked in writing by the undersigned and/or higher authorities.
