

# REPORT ON THE CONDUCTED LECTURE ON ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION AND AWARENESS HELD AT JESUS IS LORD COLLEGES FOUNDATION, INC. VICTORIA, ORIENTAL MINDORO ON SEPTEMBER 22, 2022

Pandemic brought us into some good and some bad situations. Most of the establishments were closed and limit the peoples' activity. Schools were not exempted, however one good thing happened is the reduction of waste generated from the schools. And now, they are opening the in-person classes, much more, it is expected that generation of wastes will once again escalate. For that reason, a lecture on environmental education and awareness was conducted with the theme "Balik-Eskwela, Bantay Basura at Iba Pa!" on September 22, 2022 at Jesus Is Lord Colleges Foundation, Inc. (JILCF), Victoria, Oriental Mindoro.

The event was participated by forty-one (41) male and fifty-one (51) female students and teachers.

The event started at 9:00AM with an opening prayer led by Forest Technician Charity A. Linatoc and followed by the singing of the National Anthem.. Tecaher-in-charge Jocelyn A. Tenorio welcomed the personnel from DENR CENRO Socorro while DMO IV Leo G. Capon delivered an introductory message and gave an overview about the importance of learning about climate change.

Forest Technician Charity A. Linatoc discussed the Ecological Solid Waste Management (Republic Act 9003). The topic focused on what is solid waste, the generators of solid waste and the action taken by the government to address the issue on solid waste management. Followed by Environmental Awareness and Education Act. This is governed by R.A. No. 9512, otherwise known as the National Environmental Awareness and Education Act. The lessons discussed include environmental education, environmental awareness, concepts and principles of R.A. No. 9512, environmental issues, actions to take and priority programs of the act. Participants, especially the youth, were encouraged to take a part of environmental advocacies for the better world we live.

Next presenter was EcoMS I Jose Maria M. Fontanilla. He discussed the Republic Act No. 9417 or the Wildlife Act of 2001. He discussed the importance of wildlife and the prohibited acts against wildlife. He even encourage everyone to take part on the dissemination of information and protection of any wildlife species.

Forester I Mackaley P. Martinez talked about the waterbirds and its importance in the environment. He highlighted the waterbirds found within the Naujan Lake National Park, especially the notable species of Philippine Duck "Papan" (Anas luzonica). Picture of birds were shown, he also went through a short course of talk on counting birds. Forester Martinez, open the invitation for annual waterbird census held every January. His presentation was concluded by the photo opportunity of the participants with mascot Papan.

Tayo Ang Kalikasan was then discussed by Forester I Bea Natasha R. Fortu of DENR-PENRO Oriental Mindoro. It is a citizen's platform in the Program for Restoration, Rehabilitation and Development (PRRD) which aims to provide optimized, responsible and sustainable use of country's natural, human and social resources. Further, this seeks engagement of citizenry in taking care of the agency's priority program through solid waste management, environmental protection and ecotourism. In MIMAROPA Region, the advocacy is "No to Single-Use of Plastics." Everyone is expected to be a part of the solution, whatever age groups the participants belong, for a better future of our world.

In between the discussions were games, question and answer and other challenges to motivate and keep the participants active and participative. Activities facilitated were *Pinoy Henyo* about solid waste, "No Bag, No Problem Challenge!", Artist of the Day, Mr and Ms. Youth Environmental Steward. These activities promote creativity and resourcefulness of the students.

The program ended with a closing prayer led Teacher Dahlia A. San Diego and a closing message from DENR CENRO Socorro of gratitude for the cooperation and support of the JILCF-Victoria to the programs and activities of the Department.








Prayer and singing of the National Anthem








DMO IV Leo G. Capon during the delivery of his introductory message and overview of Climate Change










