

Respectfully submitting is the report on the conducted monitoring of CBFM-CARP 2016 accomplishment for the 2nd quarter of Malampaya Pancol Multi-Purpose Cooperative (MPMPC) conducted on June 24, 2022 at Barangay Pancol, Taytay, Palawan.

The activity disclosed the monitoring of the CBFM-CARP project awarded to MPMPC located at Barangay Pancol, Taytay, Palawan which findings and observations are hereby enumerated as follows:

1. That pursuant to the Executive Order No. 263 adopting Community-Based Forest Management Program (CBFM) as national strategy to ensure the sustainable development of the country's forestland, gave a positive response to address poverty and ensure sustainable management of resources. This was strengthened by the issuance of Executive Order No. 318 known as "Sustainable Forest Management", Executive Order No. 606 known as "Sustainable Upland Development" which anchoring on food, wood and non-wood security and economic productivity. Further enhanced with Executive Order No. 616 known as "The Creation of the Anti-hunger Task Force" to address hunger both on the aspect of supply and demand for food for the upland dwellers, in particular, wherein the Malampaya Pancol Multi-Purpose Cooperative (MPMPC) is one of the beneficiaries of the said CBFM program.

2. That the aforementioned PO has been registered at the Cooperative Development Agency (CDA) in June 28, 1996 with registration no. 2512 under Pancol Multi-Purpose Cooperative (PMPC) in which on December 18, 2000, the DENR awarded the CBFMA No. RIV-PAL-CBFMA-98-01 with a total of 1,700 hectares to the PO. However, because the PO Officers had not maintained their records in the CDA, their registration has been dissolved. Nevertheless, some PO members decided to renew their CDA registration and re-organized themselves and the newly elected officers had been able to register again in the CDA under "Pancol Producers Cooperative" in 2010. After two years, the CDA allowed them to register in "multi-purpose cooperative" and acquired a new name "Malampaya Pancol Multi-Purpose Cooperative (MPMPC) in 2013. In 2013 onwards, the said PO had been a beneficiary of various projects from DENR, DOT and DA.
3. In 2016, the MPMPC acquired the CBFM-CARP project titled "Fruit Trees Production (ORCHARD) wherein different commodities had been established in 25 hectares such as Mahogany, Bamboo, Marcotted calamansi, Cacao, Lanzones, Guyabano, Dragon fruits, Banana intercropped with pineapple and vegetable crops. The PO, until 2017 had conducted various activities until the said project was completed based on their Work and Financial Plan.
4. In 2018 up to present, the PO continuously maintain the said project and gradually replaced the affected areas made by El Nino. The PO also has difficulty in the maintenance of the said project because there was no budget allotted to sustain the area, however, they made a way to weed the plantation. Also, some commodities such as Banana and Pineapple were devastated by the monkeys (eaten the fruits and shoots) and high mortality rate of guyabano was noted.
5. That on June 24, 2022, the CBFM Staff of this Office conducted the monitoring for the 2nd quarter particularly the commodities such as Marcotted Calamansi, Dragon furits, Banana intercropped with Pineapple and Bamboo. The monitoring disclosed that portion only of their plantation has been maintained.

Concerns observed during monitoring are the following, to wit:

- Unmainted plantations
- The affected commodities by the summer season were not yet replaced.
- Some of the commodities that have stunded growth were not yet replaced.

Recommendations:

- The PO should maintain the plantation area.
- Replace the dead and with stunted growth commodities.






