This Office concurs with the recommendation of the PAMO-ENTMRPA to conduct follow-up COT extraction/collection in front of Caalan beach, Bgy. Masagana, El Nido to prevent COT incursion on the said area. Continuous patrolling/monitoring within Bacuit bay of any COT infestation is also recommended. Other areas with no recorded COT infestation should also be included in the patrol plan as part of the COTs management to reduce or prevent the damaging impacts of an outbreak.
