

SUBJECT : INVESTIGATION REPORT ON THE ILLEGAL WILDLIFE POACHING AND TRANSPORT OF "PAGONG" LAND TURTLES IN BALANACAN PORT, MOGPOG, MARINDUQUE

This pertains to a subject posted on Facebook group "Marinduque News" on June 17, 2022, regarding on the illegal wildlife poaching and transport of "pagong" land turtles within Balanacan port, Mogpog, Marinduque.

Please be informed that the undersigned Forest Officers Michael Vencint Sualog, Forest Technician I, FT I Corazon Pelaez and Michael Joseph Maranan, Forest Ranger proceeded to Balanacan port to conduct initial investigation on June 23, 2022 regarding on the reported illegal poaching/transport of wildlife, the team coordinated with Philippine Port Authority (PPA) and Animal Quarantine within the area. Based on the interview with Terminal Port Manager Office (TPMO) and Sherwin Reyes, port manager, the said incidence happened on June 17, 2022, at late in the evening. The security guard on duty call to seek assistance to the personnel assigned in Animal Quarantine within the port of Brgy. Balanacan, Mogpog, Marinduque. The team immediately coordinated with Provincial Animal Quarantine during the interview with Mr. Hilario Lanete, personnel of Provincial Veterinarian Office, said that on June 17, 2022 a suspicious closed van was checked by the security guard and during the inspection they found inside the van the three (3) sacks with forty-six (46) pieces "pagong" land turtles". Upon verification it was found out that the transport of wildlife had no transport permit from the DENR. Accordingly, a certain Wilson B. Olaget from Manila was bought those turtles to someone who came from Barangay Murillion, Boac Marinduque. Thus, they immediately confiscated the forty-six (46) land turtles "pagong" and was temporarily placed under the custody of Mr. Hilario Lanete.

Further, on June 23, 2022 the team conducted inspection of the confiscated wildlife. It was identified as Malagayan Box Turtle and the status is a vulnerable species. Please be informed that there was only thirty-six (36) pieces of turtles was seen in the facility of Mr. Lanete.


Furthermore, on June 24, 2022 the undersigned together with FT I Corazon Pelaez coordinated with Mr. Josue M. Victoria, designated provincial veterinarian regarding the releasing of the said turtles. Mr. Victoria advised us to identify the suitable sites for its releasing. As we agreed, we selected Danao Lake at Barangay Duyay, Boac, Marinduque since the turtles thrive within the area. We also, first conducted inspection and observations of the area and mostly the like turtles were thriving therein.

RECOMMENDATION:


In view of the foregoing, collection and illegal transport of wildlife without a permit from the DENR is prohibited under Republic Act no. 9147 under sections 7 and 8. It is respectfully recommended that Mr. Wilson B. Olaget be summon by this Office for any administrative proceedings applicable.

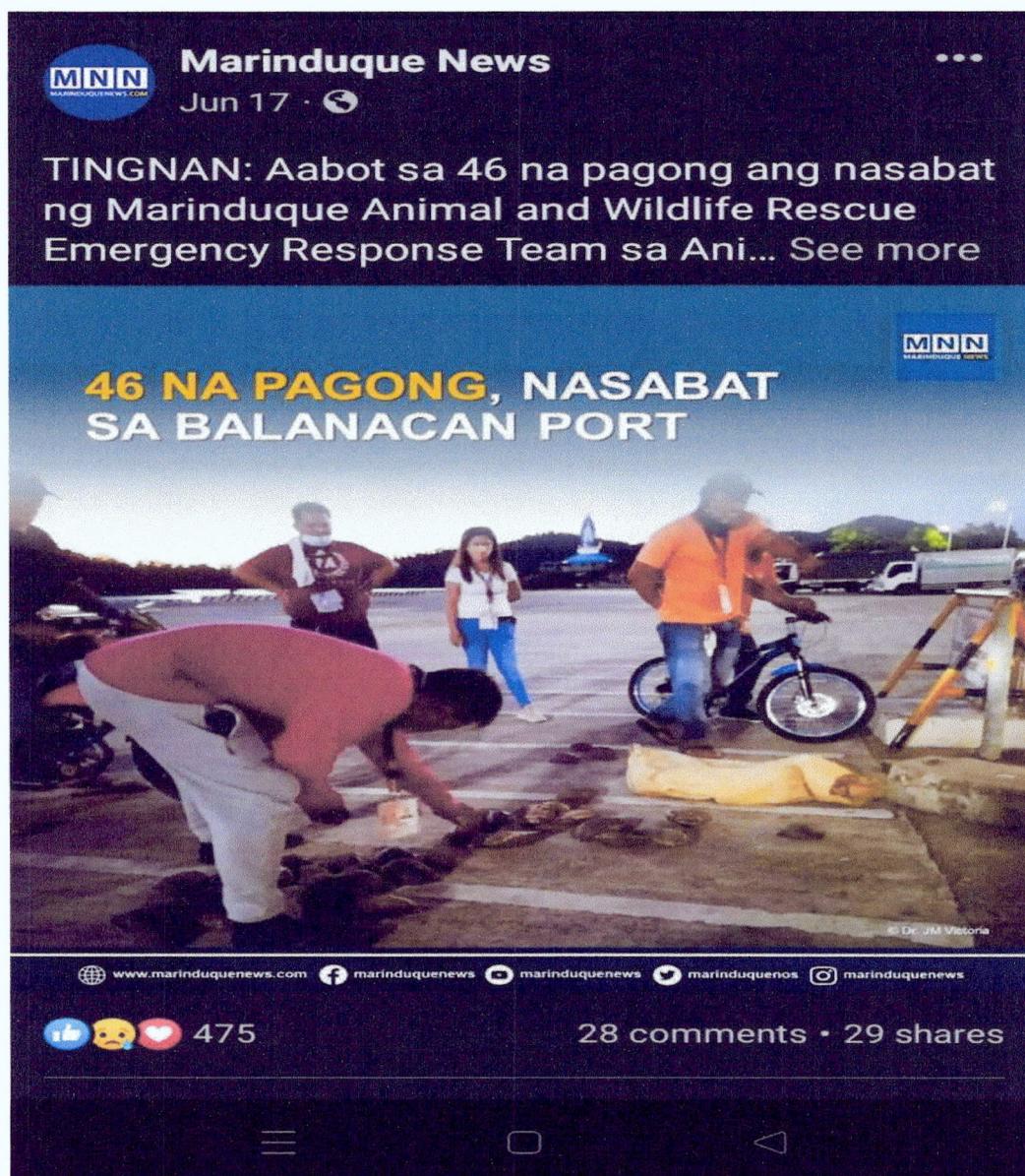

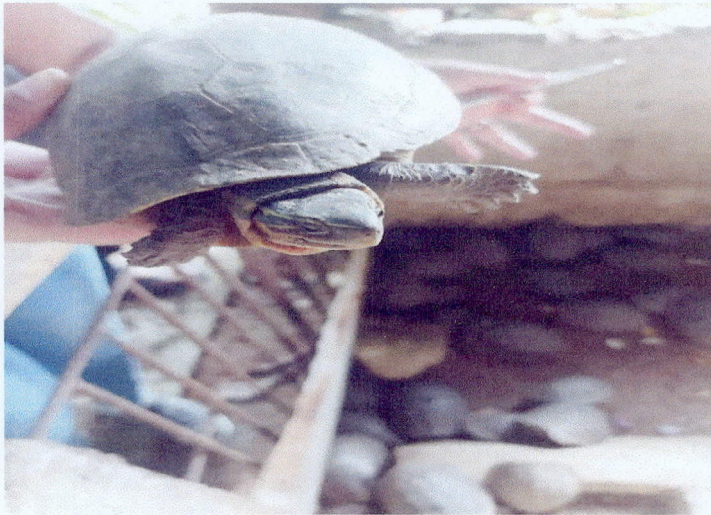
