Respectfully submitted herewith is the report on the conducted coastal clean-up activity on August 18-19, 2022 at Barangay Poblacion V, Coron, Palawan under the implementation of Green Economy Model coastal clean-up activity.

The first day clean-up drive was participated by 35 individuals from DENR CENRO Coron, 4P's member, Barangay Officials and youth of Poblacion V. Likewise, the second day clean-up drive was participated by 91 individuals from the Calamianes Association Tourism Establishment (CATE) members; Tag Resort, Two Seasons, Sanho Resort, Fraternal Order of Eagles, Calamianes Divers Association Inc. (CDAI), Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), PNP Maritime, DENR- CENRO Coron personnel, BPRMO and Environmental Management Bureau (EMB).

A total of seventy-eight (78) sacks were collected approximately 1,224 kilograms (gross weight) of garbage were collected from the 2-day activity.

MODEL IMPLEMENTATION

Every year thousands tons of garbage waste wind up on the ocean mostly plastics that last a very long time and harmful to marine life. In effort to reduce the plastic waste the Green Economy Model project is set to implement Proper Waste Disposal as one of its target for FY 2022, this includes the conduct of coastal clean-up drive activities on identified GEM sites.

On August 18-19, 2022, the DENR CENRO Coron in collaboration with BLGU of Poblacion V, Coron, Palawan initiated a coastal clean-up drive on at the adjacent of Reclamation Area.

The clean-up activity on August 18, 2022 was spearheaded by Brgy. Captain Lanie Lungay together with the GEM team. This was participated by 35 individuals from 4P's member, Barangay Officials and youth of Poblacion 5. About thirty (30) regular size sacks of garbage were collected and a total of 264 kilograms of recyclable and residual wastes were segregated and turnover to the local government unit to earn raffle ticket for their "Basuraffle" Program.

On the other hand, a total of 48 large sacks approximately 960 kilograms (gross weight) were collected the next day (August 19, 2022) and was actively participated by 91 individuals from the Calamianes Association Tourism Establishment (CATE) members; Tag Resort, Two Seasons, Sanho Resort, Fraternal Order of Eagles, Calamianes Divers Association Inc. (CDAI), Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), PNP Maritime, DENR- CENRO Coron personnel, BPRMO and Environmental Management Bureau (EMB).

The collected waste materials on the 2-day clean-up were comprised mostly of plastics (pet bottles, cellophanes, styrofoam, nylon fishing lines, junkfoods and candy wrappers), used diapers, fabric wastes, glass bottles, excess boat materials presumably disposed by the boat operators docking along the reclamation, and from establishments and households adjacent to the area.


Moreover, the BLGU and LGU initiative program such as "Basura Palit School Supplies" and "Basuraffle" that both aims to address the arising problems on solid waste with the engagement of youth is noteworthy. The collected garbage was hauled by the Barangay Tanod of Bgy. Poblacion V and Coron Solid Waste Management for proper disposal.
