


**LAWIN PA MORE.** The participants and facilitators during the Training on Lawin Forest and Biodiversity Protection System for Taytay Conservation Enforcers and Stakeholders was organized by USAID Safe Water Project on July 19-21, 2022 at Josil Pension, Sitio Culanga, Poblacion, Taytay, Palawan.

Please be informed, the undersigned attended re: the above mentioned subject. A three-day Training on Lawin Forest and Biodiversity Protection System for Taytay Conservation Enforcers and Stakeholders was organized by USAID Safe Water Project on July 19-21, 2022 at Josil Pension, Sitio Culanga, Poblacion, Taytay, Palawan. Participated by 25 individuals composed of forest rangers of Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) of Taytay, barangay officials of Barangay Bantulan and the members of Lake Manguao Community and Indigenous People Agriculture Cooperative (LMCIPAC).

First day of training was focused on Introduction to Lawin Forest and Biodiversity Protection System which was discussed by the undersigned, followed by discussion on Recording Patrol Information and Observations, CyberTracker Walkthrough and Simulation Exercises by Ms. Jackie Wenceslao of USAID-Safe Water. Second day was the actual conduct of LAWIN Patrolling and Monitoring within the vicinity of Lake Manguao Conservation Area and the last day, presentation of Patrol Effort and Patrol Data, Response Protocol and Patrol Planning. They also discussed the Forest Cover Status of Lake Manguao and Taytay Watersheds.

The undersigned, in his talk emphasized the important role of every Filipino citizen in environmental protection and conservation. Section 3 of Presidential Decree No. 1151 or otherwise known as Philippine

Environmental Policy states that “Right to a Healthy Environment. In furtherance of these goals and policies, the Government recognizes the right of the people to a healthy environment. It shall be the duty and responsibility of each individual to contribute to the preservation and enhancement of the Philippine environment.” On behalf of the CENRO, he extended and recognized the effort of non-government organizations (NGOs), Local Government Unit (LGU) of Taytay through MENRO, and people’s organization - LMCIPAC for their dedication to conserve and preserve the rich biodiversity of Lake Manguao, a Municipal Conservation Area. He added that the creation of LAWIN patroller team amongst the stakeholders of Lake Manguao is a big help to reduce and eventually eliminate threats within the said conservation area so that forest condition can improve.

The organizational collaboration and institutional arrangements are encouraged to engage such as local government units (LGUs), non-governmental organizations (NGOs), people’s organizations (POs), and private

sector partners in implementing LAWIN. Patrolling and responding to threats greatly benefit from collaborative efforts.

Moreover, to further intensify the enforcement initiatives, this Office strengthen the Multi-sectoral Forest Protection Committee (MFPC) that resulting to deputation of Environment and Natural Resources Officers, as of this writing, this Office have approved 11 DENROs as per Regional Special Orders (RSO) 217 and 218 dated July 22, 2022 signed by Regional Executive Director Lormelyn E. Claudio, CESO IV, DENR MIMAROPA. In addition, another NGO, the Zoological Society of London (ZSL) in Taytay, Palawan has existing request for DENRO. This Office is still waiting for the approval. DENR is mandated to involve the citizenry in the protection and conservation of the environment and natural resources, DENROs are given the responsibility to assist in the enforcement of environmental laws, rules, and regulations as well as in the issuance of apprehension receipts and in the conduct of ENR information campaign, among others.

Meanwhile, the undersigned recommends for the refresher/training among LAWIN patrollers in collaboration with USAID-Safe Water, ZSL and C3 Philippines. Refresher/training is needed to maintain the quality patrol and to address other concerns in implementation of LAWIN in our level. At the same time, evaluate the patrol performance of patrollers for future discussions and action taken.
