Submitted is the accomplishment report of CENRO Roxas on Enhanced National Greening Program (ENGP) targets within ELCAC Barangays for the month of August, 2022.

Based on the report, a total of 121,656 seedlings/propagules planted within 269 hectares ENGP plantations located at Brgy. San Isidro and Brgy. Milagrosa, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro. The ENGP plantations contracted by the four (4) People's Organization with forty-five (45) families involved. At present, all POs continue conducting maintenance and protection activities stipulated on WFP such as patrolling, ring weeding/brushing, maintenance of firelines, etc.

For the financial status, a total of Php605,250.00 or 45% of the Php1.345 million allotted budget was already disbursed.
