



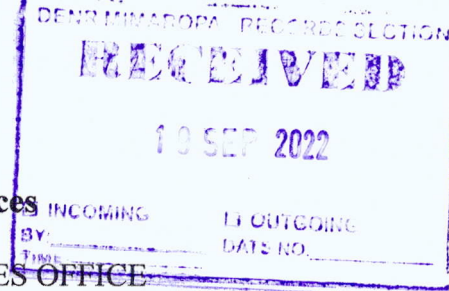

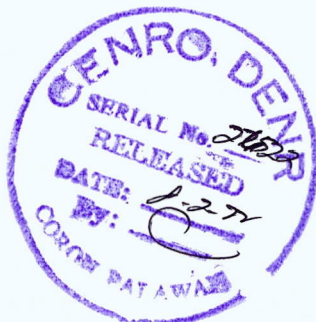


Respectfully forwarded is the attached monitoring report dated July 29, 2022 submitted by the team in compliance to CENRO Special Order No. 019, Series of 2022.

Report revealed that dumping and other reclamation activities were stopped but flooding was observed in the area due to heavy rain and inflow of sea water during high tide.

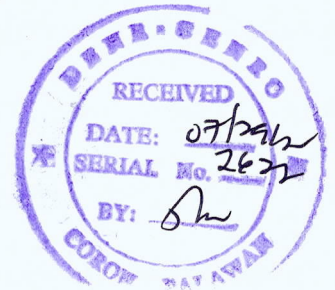

This pertains to the monitoring and patrolling conducted today (July 29, 2022) at the reclamation area in Brgys. 2, 3 and 5, Coron, Palawan.

Please be informed that there is no man-made activity/s observed in the area during the monitoring, however flooding was observed due to the constant heavy rain. In addition, during high tide, the water level overflow because of the absence of seawall.

It was also observed during the monitoring and patrolling that there are waste materials that are dumped and some are scattered in Barangay 3. The undersigned advised the Environment Monitoring Officer (EnMO) to inform the concerned barangay officials regarding the matter.
