A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING HONORABLE CITY MAYOR LUCILO R. 
WHEREAS, Article II, Section 16 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution declares, that "The State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature";

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b), (1), (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", provides, that: "For efficient, effective and economical governance the purpose of which is the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of the same Code, the City Mayor shall exercise general supervision and control over all programs, projects, services and activities of the City Government. In this connection, the City Mayor shall represent the city in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance";

WHEREAS, the same code gives Local Government Units (LGUs) primary authority in disaster rehabilitation and recovery response within their respective jurisdictions;

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2021, Typhoon Odette caused extensive damage in the Province of Palawan, particularly in Puerto Princesa City, and the municipalities of Roxas, Taytay, El Nido, Dumaran and Araceli, destroying forestlands where forest trees were toppled/uprooted causing heavy siltation/sedimentation of water

bodies, destroying residential houses, government facilities and infrastructure, water supply, electric power, and communication facilities:

WHEREAS, it is of record that typhoons affect several political jurisdictions, and the magnitude of the devastation and huge amount of resources needed to restore normalcy in affected areas overwhelm local government resources and manpower;

WHEREAS, in his letter dated April 11, 2022, Atty. Arnel M. Pedrosa, City Administrator, requested for an authority for the Honorable City Mayor Lucilo R. Bayron to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) for the collaborative efforts on retrieval operations, processing and disposition of fallen/uprooted trees due to Typhoon Odette:

WHEREAS, under the Memorandum of Agreement, the City Government shall lead in the provision of logistical support such as chainsaws and trucks for the retrieval of logs and the transport and delivery thereof from the damaged forest areas to the on-site/off-site processing site/area and extend manpower and other logistical assistance in the inventory, monitoring, and validation of the retrieved/harvested fallen/uprooted trees in the damaged forest areas in the City;

WHEREAS, this Honorable Body, after thorough deliberation, finds the said request in order and in the interest of the populace hence, the passage of this measure.

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Victor S. Oliveros, City Councilor, Majority Floor Leader,

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to authorizing Honorable City Mayor Lucilo R. Bayron to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), for and on behalf of the City Government of Puerto Princesa, with the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), the Natural Resources Development Corporation, the Provincial Government of Palawan, the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development, and the Palawan Chamber of Commerce and Industry for the collaborative efforts on retrieval operations, processing and disposition of fallen/uprooted trees due to Typhoon Odette.

RESOLVED further, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to Honorable City Mayor Lucilo R. Bayron, the City Administrator, the City Legal Officer, the City Information Officer, all of this City, and the Department of Environment and Natural Resources – MIMAROPA for their information and appropriate action.
