SUBJECT : **SMALL GROUP STAKEHOLDERS CONSULTATION MEETING
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF VERDE ISLAND PASSAGE AS A
PROTECTED AREA UNDER THE NIPAS**

This has reference to the outcome of the DENR consultation workshop conducted on 20-22 April 2022 in Batangas City. During the meeting, it was agreed to commence with the conduct of the major activities for the Protected Area Suitability Assessment (e.g., on-site data collection and key informant interview for PASA Forms 1 and 2, and PASA Report Writeshop) for the proposed establishment of VIP as a protected area under the RA 7586 known as the National Integrated Protected Areas System (NIPAS) as amended by RA 11038 also known as Extended NIPAS.

As one of the steps identified after the workshop, our Office will be conducting a hybrid (face-to-face and virtual) meeting at 9:00 AM on 8 August 2022 to discuss the development of the roadmap towards the establishment of VIP as NIPAS MPAs 2022 and present the salient points of the draft bill on VIP. Relative to this, we are honored to invite your Office to the face-to-face meeting at the Training Center of the Ninoy Aquino Parks and Wildlife Center, North Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City.
