


Per DENR- PENRO Special Order as numbered, please be informed that the undersigned facilitated the conduct Technical Assistance on MPA Networking for VIP-MPAN & LEN (Maghali Network) for the third quarter CY-2022 held on August 24, 2022 at Dream Paradise Mountain Resort, Brgy. Mapula, Romblon, Romblon.

### I. BACKGROUND

A Marine Protected Area Network (MPAN) is defined as a collection of individual marine protected areas operating cooperatively and synergistically, at various spatial scales, and with a range of protection levels, in order to fulfill ecological aims more effectively and comprehensively than individual sites could alone. The network will also display social and economic benefits, though the latter may only become fully developed over long time frames as ecosystems recover.

Moreover, MPA Networks contribute to sustainable development goals by fostering integrated ocean and coastal management. Networks can also help reduce the degradation of coastal and marine habitats, slow the loss of endangered marine species, and restore depleted fisheries.

In the province of Romblon, included in the Verde Island Passage Marine Protected Area Network (VIP-MPAN) are the three (3) island municipalities of Banton, Corcuera, and Concepcion. As part of the technical assistance, we need to regularly convene the management body in order to share updates and discuss the way forward on the conservation, protection and management of the Verde Island Passage Marine Protected Area.



### II. OBJECTIVES

General: To strengthen the Maghali MPA Network in the municipalities of Banton, Corcuera and Concepcion.

### Specific:

- 1. To increase level of awareness of the coastal communities through engagement of key stakeholders in the management of established MPA Network through social marketing approach; and
- 3. To mobilize support of the local communities and other key stakeholders in the protection and development of the marine protected area.

### III. STRATEGIES & PROCESSES/METHODS

The DENR PENRO-CDS will lead and facilitate the activity through active involvement of concerned LGUs, PG-ENRO, BFAR, PCG, PNP Maritime, Romblon PPO and RSU.

### IV. FUNDING



### V. ACTIVITY REPORT

This Office facilitated the conduct of "3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter Technical Assistance on MPA Networking for VIP-MPAN & LEN (Maghali Network)" held on August 24, 2022 at Dream Paradise Mountain Resort, Brgy. Mapula, Romblon, Romblon.

It was attended by thirty (30) participants composing of twenty-three (23) male and seven (7) female primarily from law enforcement agencies such as PNP maritime, Philippine Coast Guard, and Romblon PPO along with representatives from PG-ENRO, BFAR, and the DENR-PENRO CDS as the facilitator and secretariat. Also present via Zoom virtual meetings is the municipality of Banton, Romblon. Because of inclement weather condition due to Typhoon Florita, participants from the three island municipalities was not able to attend physically in the said meeting.

The Opening Program started about 9:30 in the morning led by CDS Secretariat. ECOMS II Janice F. Forcadas hosted the opening program. Mr. Delfin Mores of PG-ENRO led the



opening prayer followed by the singing of the Philippine National Anthem thru video presentation.

In behalf of Provincial Governor Jose R. Riano, Chief of Staff Ronald M. Geronimo delivered the warm welcome remarks. He expressed the full support of the provincial government in our goal to protect and conserve the Verde Island Passage Marine Protected Area Network. He emphasized our responsibility in the protection of the natural resources since we are part of our environment and we are the environment ourselves.

DENR-PENRO Chief, MSD Thelmo S. Hernandez gave an inspirational message. He acknowledged and welcomed the participants as well as discussed a brief overview of the activity. He assured that the agency would continue to provide technical assistance to the network until the proclamation of VIP under NIPAS. Likewise, he recognized the efforts of the stakeholders particularly the LGUs and the partner agencies in fulfilling their roles and responsibilities in the conservation, protection and management of the Verde Island Passage Marine Corridor.


OIC-PFO Luisito Manes of BFAR gave a message and words of commitment. He expressed the continuous commitment of BFAR towards marine conservation on our municipal waters, in collaboration with the LGUs, DENR and other national agencies. He also appealed to the LGUs to focus on our municipal waters and incorporate at least one fishery commodity in the Provincial Commodity Investment Plan in order to secure funding.

Afterwards, photo opportunity was conducted with the participants.

For the meeting proper, Coastal Unit Head, For. Marielle V. Magallanes presented the highlights of the previous meeting conducted last June 23, 2022 at Lyn's Fern Garden, Budiong, Odiongan, Romblon. This is in order to refresh the participants of the discussions and agreements reached by the stakeholders last quarter.

Then, the law enforcement network presented their updates regarding their activities particularly within the three (3) island municipalities of Banton, Corcuera, and Concepcion. Sub Station Commander CG PO1 Ruel Balao presented for the Philippine Coast Guard, followed by Station Chief PLT Aileen R. Seño of PNP Maritime, and PSSg Ferdie H. Vibo of Romblon PPO.

The Philippine Coast Guard reported that this year, they have conducted three (3) coastal clean-up activities and four (4) mangrove tree planting activities. They also conducted more or less three hundred (300) seaborne coastal security patrols to monitor all possible illegal activities within the area of responsibility. Lastly, on August 12, 2022, CGSS Banton



personnel successfully apprehended one (1) illegal fishing activity at the vicinity waters of Dos Hermanas, Brgy. Libtong, Banton, Romblon.

The PNP Maritime reported that they are conducting mangrove planting and coastal clean-up activities as well as seaborne patrolling on municipal waters. They are also conducting boat registration caravan wherein they are conducting Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) campaigns to fisherfolks regarding fishery and environmental laws.


Romblon Police Provincial Office (Romblon PPO) reported that for the period of January to August 2022, there are 21 reported cases on illegal fishing and violation of Municipal Ordinances within Maghali Network (Banton-6, Concepcion-7, and Corcuera-8). They have also conducted one hundred thirty-three (133) coastal clean-up activities province-wide. In connection to their goal to plant at least one million trees in the region by the end of 2022, Romblon PPO had already accomplished 75% of its goal as of August 2022.

For the afternoon session, the municipality of Banton presented the status and updates of their respective Coastal and Marine Ecosystems Management Program (CMEMP) activities. Due to unstable internet connection, Mr. Delfin Mores of PG-ENRO reported the updates of Banton in behalf of MAO Garry F. Fano.

They presented the status and updates of their CMEMP activities by discussing their accomplishments, best practices, as well as their issues and concerns regarding its management.

The municipality of Banton reported that in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter, their seaborne patrol operations conducted have apprehended a total of 30 illegal fishermen from nearby municipality and from two municipalities of Marinduque. A coastal area at barangay Mainit and Sibay have been planted with mangrove seedlings by LGU and MPS personnel as well as youth/children and women sectors. Certain sectors in all seventeen (17) barangays have participated in the Synchronized Provincial-wide Tree Planting Activity wherein four hundred twenty four (424) mixed forest trees were planted as reported by all barangays. They also conducted IEC in collaboration with PG-ENRO on the role of the community for conservation, protection and management of fishery resources prior to establishment of MPA. Lastly, PG-ENRO personnel conducted resource assessment through "manta tow" in the proposed marine fish sanctuary at the barangays of Sibay, Togong, and Balogo.

Afterwards, Chief CDS Arlyn D. Balibag presented the harmonized Action Plan of Maghali Network. Since the participants were mostly from the law enforcement agencies, the presentation only focused on Area 4 – Governance, Policy and Marine Law Enforcement. It was suggested to include unification of fishery ordinances among the three municipalities. For



sustainable financing, it was also suggested that each LGU must allocate budget for the network yearly as well as lobby the plans to the provincial governor for financing.


Then, Chief CDS Arlyn D. Balibag facilitated the revisit of Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) for the institutionalization of the Maghali Coastal and Marine Law Enforcement Network in the Verde Island Passage of the Province of Romblon. This is in order to refresh the roles of the LGUs and the different agencies such as the PG-ENRO, DA-BFAR, PCG, PNP Maritime, and the Romblon PPO in the protection of the VIP specifically Maghali Network since most of the signatories in the MOA was no longer in service or already been exchanged.

The role of the PG-ENRO as the Secretariat for Maghali Network was emphasized wherein they should be responsible for the overall coordination and oversight to the operations of the Network. Although the DENR is not part of the MOA, the agency is always willing to provide technical assistance to the Network and its operations to ensure sustainable management, conservation, and protection of the VIP.

Afterwards, CDS Chief Arlyn D. Balibag facilitated the ways forward of the activity. The agreements reached during the meeting are the following: (1) facilitate the development of sustainable financing plan or discussion on possible technical and financial support from external groups; (2) indicate how the network will conduct a performance assessment of the management body; (3) presentation of harmonized Action Plan to the Governor and Local Chief Executives; (4) revisit MOA of Maghali MPAN; (5) reorganization of the Management Body; (6) conduct of joint law enforcement activities; and (7) schedule and venue for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter meeting on October 10-15, 2022 at Banton, Romblon.

Lastly, DENR-PENRO CDS Secretariat led a short closing program. PLT COL Raquel Martinez pledge commitment and partnership with the DENR, BFAR, and other agencies in the continuous protection of our environment especially our Verde Island Passage.

ECOMS II Raymund G. Inocencio ended the program by giving a synthesis of the activity expressing his gratitude for a successful event despite the inclement weather condition due to the typhoon. He also recognized the efforts of the Maghali Law Enforcement Network (LEN) in the intensified protection of our VIP.



### Conclusion/Recommendation:

The Maghali Network took another step forward to strengthen their Marine Protected Area Network through the involvement, partnership and collaboration among the different national agencies such as the DENR, DA-BFAR, PG-ENRO, PNP Maritime, Romblon PPO and the Romblon State University.














