

Respectfully submitting the Lawin Patrol Plan for October to December 2022 of CENRO Puerto Princesa.

Please be informed that CENRO Puerto Princesa is composed of two sectors with a total of Seventeen (17) Lawin patrollers. The North Sector (with approximately 100,000 hectares of natural forest and 406.13 hectares of NGP graduated areas) is under the leadership of Forest Protection & Law Enforcement Chief For. Arjay Gregas and Team Leader FR Raymund Sapalo and FR Neil James Verzosa. While the South Sector (with approximately 83,000 hectares of natural forest and 979.65 NGP graduated areas) is led by Forest Protection & Law Enforcement Chief For. Lim Bryan Kutat and Team Leader FT1 Rommel Adato, FR Roldan Mercado and FR Armando Dolor.

Conservation targets	Forest loss will be reduced by 6% per year starting 2017. Maintain the water quality of rivers, streams, lakes, wetlands and other water bodies within the next five years to guarantee sufficient supply of clean water for both rural and urban areas. Maintain the remaining natural forest and residual forests to serve as habitat and breeding grounds for the endemic species specially those identified as indicator species. The visibility of the patrollers will be increased to raise the awareness of the community regarding environmental issues and concerns.




