
Respectfully forwarded is the memorandum dated August 31, 2022 from CENRO Quezon, Palawan with attached CBFMA monitoring and assessment report conducted by the CBFM monitoring team on August 2, 2022 within the CBFM Area of Bugon Multi-purpose Cooperative (BMPC) at Barangay Sowangan, Quezon, Palawan.

Per report of the CENRO, the CBFM Agreement of BMPC is recommended for cancellation to wit;

1. The CBFM PO is inactive for almost ten (10) years due to lack of interest of Peoples Organization (PO) officers and members.
2. Some officers already passed away and no members took over the duties and responsibilities of the PO.
3. Approximately 30% of the CBFM area was already reclassified as Alienable and Disposable Land per Project No. 13-0 of LC Map No. 3354 approved on January 14, 1986 and already titled to different individuals.

In view of this, this Office concurs with the recommendation of the CENRO for the cancellation of the CBFM area of Bugon Multi-purpose Cooperative (BMPC).

Please be informed that the personnel from Monitoring and Enforcement Section (MES) and Conservation and Development Section (CDS) conducted monitoring and assessment within the CBFM area of BMPC on August 2, 2022 in Barangay Sowangan, Quezon, Palawan. Likewise, the team conducted interview to eleven (11) respondents comprising of eight (8) male and three (3) female.

Further, as per recommendations of the team, the CBFM Agreement issued to BMPC is subject for cancellation, also, requesting for technical assistance to assess the CBFM area, due to the following reasons, to wit:

1. The status of awarded CBFMA is inactive for almost ten (10) years due to lack of interest of PO Officers and members.
2. Some Officers already passed away and no members took over the duties and responsibilities of the P.O.
3. Approximately 30% of the CBFMA area is declared as Alienable and Disposable Land and already titled to different individuals.

NARRATIVE REPORT FOR BUGON MULTI- PURPOSE COOPERATIVE (BMPC) ON COMMUNITY BASED FOREST MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT MONITORING

I. IDENTIFYING INFORMATION

The Bugon Multi-Purpose Cooperative (BMPC) is registered with the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) on December 21, 2001 under CBFM Agreement No. RIV-PAL-CBFMA-2001-26.

The CBFMA has a total land area of fifteen point eight hundred ninety eight (15.898) hectares located in Bgy. Sowangan, Quezon, Palawan. Approximately thirty (30) percent of the land cover is declared as Alienable and Disposable Land and already titled to different individuals.

However, The BMPC-PO Chairman Evelyn Alilano-Baal and Vice Chairman, Victoriana B. Aquino already passed away years ago.

II. LIVELIHOOD/ENTERPRISE DEVELOPMENT

In the past few years no livelihood projects has been implemented in the CBFM area due to the status of the awarded CBFMA and non-participatory/lack of interest of PO Officers and members.

III. CURRENT SITUATION

The CBFMA area was previously planted with upland rice (kaingin). At present, a secondary-growth forest is visible in the said area; it is because the P.O. didn't introduce any cultivations or improvements in the area due to lack of interest for a long period of time. Hence, different tree species were found in the area like Depanga, Mangis, Antipolo, Salong, Lampong, Apitong and Banga. Fruit trees like Coconut and Durian also visible in the area. Cash crops such as banana and cassava were also found in the CBFM area.

Further, newly constructed feeder road was also visible in the adjacent area of CBFM introduced by the Local Government Unit of Quezon, Palawan.



IV. FINDINGS/ OBSERVATIONS IN THE CONDUCTED INTERVIEW

a. Information about the Respondents

The interview was conducted to eleven (11) respondents comprising of eight (8) male and three (3) female. Wherein, among the 11 respondents only four (4) of them are members while 7 are non-members of BMPC. Further, there were three (3) respondents occupying within the CBFM and eight (8) respondents occupying area adjacent of CBFM.

The age group of the respondents categorized as **early adult**, aged between 25 to 35 years old; **middle aged group**, aged between 36 to 51 years old, **old age**, aged between 52 to 67 years old; and **elderly, for age** above 67 years old. Majority of the respondents were fall under middle aged group. In terms of ethnic affiliation, the respondents were dominated by Bisaya tribe. Farming is considered as the main source of their income.

b. Status of Community Based Forest Management (CBFM)

During the conducted interview to the respondents, six (6) of them answered that they are familiar with the BMPC while, five (5) of them answered that they are not familiar with the BMPC. All of the respondents answered that the status of awarded CBFMA is inactive due to lack of interest of PO Officers and members.

V. ISSUES AND CONCERNs

Issues and concerns were raised by the respondents during the conducted interview, to wit:

1. The status of awarded CBFMA is inactive due to lack of interest of PO Officers and members;
2. Some Officers and members was already passed away and no members took over the duties and responsibilities of the P.O; and
3. Approximately thirty (30) percent of the CBFMA area declared as Alienable and Disposable Land and already titled to different individuals.

VI. MONITORING AND ASSESSMENT

The personnel from Monitoring and Enforcement Section (MES) and Conservation and Development Section (CDS) conducted monitoring and assessment together with the students/OJT from Western Philippines University- Aborlan, Palawan Campus within the CBFM area of BMPC on August 2, 2022 in Barangay Sowangan, Quezon, Palawan.


