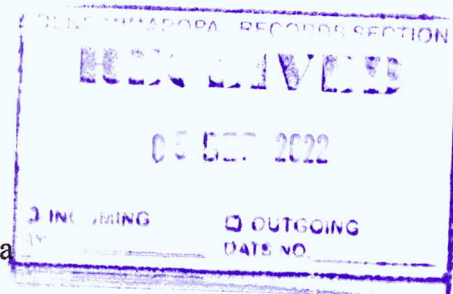

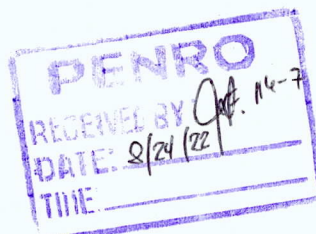
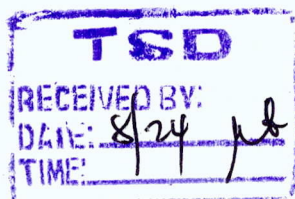

NARRATIVE REPORT




