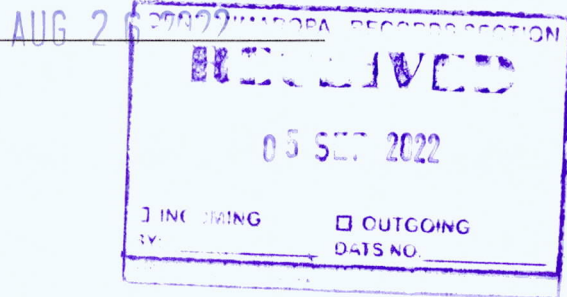

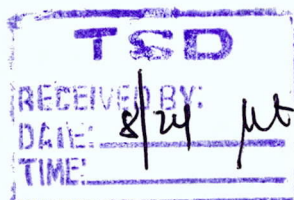



### NARRATIVE


DENR is the primary agency assigned to protect the Countries Environment and Natural Resources. As part of the enforcement and Monitoring activity of DENR CENRO Sablayan, port monitoring were conducted regularly to secure the 0% importation of wildlife to protect the environment and natural resources. Part of the doings is to check and inspect all suspected vehicle that may carry wildlife or other illegal forest product. This activity is given to the Enforcement and Monitoring Section (EMS) of CENRO Offices.

Monitoring of Abra de ilog sea port located at Barangay Lumangbayan, Abra de ilog, Occidental Mindoro was conducted last August 4, 2022. All vehicle, sea vesel (motorized banca) and RORO shipping lines bound to Puerto Galera and Batangs City were searched to ensure that was no illegal forest activity will transpire. After 24 hours of duty and monitoring, illegal forest activity is not observed.

On august 10, 2022, selected Enforcement and Monitoring Section (EMS) personnel of DENR-CENRO Sablayan were deployed to monitor Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines, Mamburao, Airport, Occidental Mindoro. No air craft were present during the monitoring, illegal forest activity is not observed.

Selected EMS personnel were deployed and monitored the sea port of Sablayan located at Barangay Poblacion at the said municipality on August 19, 2022, every suspected vehicle and sea vessel was inspected. After 24 hours of duty were no illegal activity encountered during the monitoring.

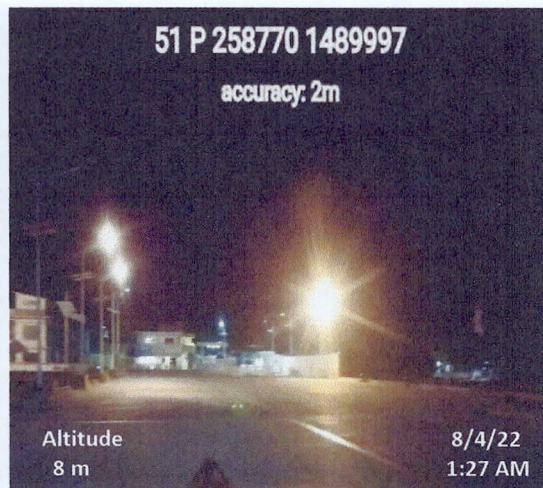
