REPORT OF THE NATIONAL DISASTER RESILIENCE MONTH 2022 AT CALINTAAN, OCCIDENTAL MINDORO

In the celebration of the National Disaster Resilience Month with the theme, "Sambayanang Pilipino, Nagkakaisa tungo sa Katatagan at Maunlad na Kinabukasan", the DENR CENRO San Jose in partnership with the Task Force Cali-Kasan conducted its Phase V of Bamboolution project at the river area of Barangay Malpalon, Calintaan, Occidental Mindoro.

The bamboo planting activity was held primarily at the area where it is necessary to establish protection projects since the community surrounding the river is vulnerable to flooding. During the event, short program was held then immediately proceeded with CENRO Efren L. delos Reyes' demonstration of the planting procedure to execute. According to Punong Barangay Sanny T. Morella, they have been consistently conducting the same activities annually because they acknowledge the need to plant bamboos for the protection of the community, however, the success rate was low specifically because of the lack of project maintenance and protection initiatives. They also realized that the timing and procedure of planting was inappropriate.

In order to ensure the survival of the planted bamboos, this Office together with LGU Calintaan and BLGU of Malpalon agreed to conduct regular monitoring and maintenance and protection activities within the area. PB Morella said that he will be assigning barangay police to facilitate the monitoring with its results to be submitted to MENRO Calintaan. It was also agreed to partner with volunteer organizations to protect the project.
