



Please be informed that the Chief, Conservation and Development Section (CDS) and the undersigned have attended and provided technical assistance to the conduct of the International Coastal Area Management (ICAM) planning workshop on August 9-10 2022 at Southdrive Restaurant, Maujao, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro

The activity was facilitated by the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro thru the Provincial Agriculturist's Office – Fisheries Management Division. Participants of the workshop are the Barangay Captains of Bulalacao – Coastal Resources Management Coordinators of different municipalities, Municipal Agriculturist, MENRO and Department of Environment and Natural Resources Office thru the PENRO.

The first on the agenda was the presentation of other agency regarding the International Coastal Management. The workshop was about ridge to reef concerns. This office, however, expressed its intent and support in the conduct activities, also, to provide assistance to the other participants regarding the Coastal management and also to provide assistance to the community into provision of livelihood thru the Biodiversity-Friendly Enterprise (BDFE).

Members of the workshop planning have reported/ shared their plans/programs/activities regarding Intentional Coastal Area Management. Planning Officer I Jezreel John Matre discussed different projects of DENR in Municipality of Bulalacao. He also presented some accomplish projects of municipality. The agency have committed on the provision of technical assistance to the Municipality of Bulalacao regarding Coastal Management. In addition, For. Amor presented the PASA of Suguicay Island, she said that Suguicay Island has a possibility to become Protected Area because of different characteristic of the Island. In this regard, they said the possible situation of the island if ever the area become a protected areas.

Further, Forester Amor discussed about the Integrated Coastal Management as a strategy to ensure the sustainable development of the coastal and marine environment and resources. It was also explained to the LGU some programs of the office that in line with International Coastal Management. LGUs shall conduct activities to consolidate some issues and concerns regarding the coastal management however, it also update their respective ICM programs to reflect changing socials, economic and environmental condition. Municipality of Bulalacao and City government shall consider the ICM as their regular functions. Scheduling activities of the municipality were raised thru discussion, agreements and commitments.

This office also provided the food during the conduct of the International Coastal Areas Management Planning Workshop at Southdrive Restaurant, Maujao, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro.
