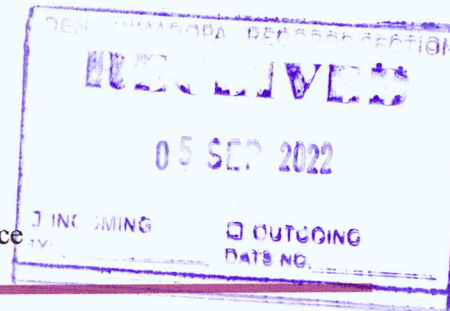

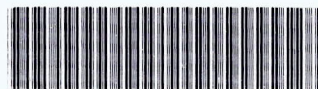
**SUBJECT** : **REPORT ON THE RELEASE OF HAWKSBILL TURTLE AT

Submitted is the report of CENRO Roxas on the release of one (1) Hawksbill Sea Turtle (*Eretmochelys imbricate*) along the shoreline of So. Bating, Barangay Milagrosa, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro on August 18, 2022.

The said species was in good condition upon observation and was measured and noted to have a carapace length of 37cm and width of 35cm. Further, it was appropriately tagged with serial number PH 1308 before it was released back to the wild. The activity was headed by the CENRO Roxas personnel along with the Barangay Officials and NGP PO partners.

Submitted herewith is the report of the Protected Area Coastal and Management Unit (PACMU) with regards to the above-cited subject.

One (1) *Eretmochelys imbricate* or commonly known as Hawksbill Sea Turtle was reported by Mr. Rackefeller S. Merida – a fisherfolk of So. Bating, Barangay Milagrosa, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro. He informed the DENR CENRO Office Personnel and immediately acted on it. Upon interviewing, Mr. Merida, he stated that the sea turtle was tangled on his fishing net and he immediately reported it to the authorized agency. The marine turtle has a carapace length of 37 cm and width of 35 cm. It was tagged with serial number of PH 1308 M and released back in good health condition with the help of Barangay Officials and NGP PO Partners.

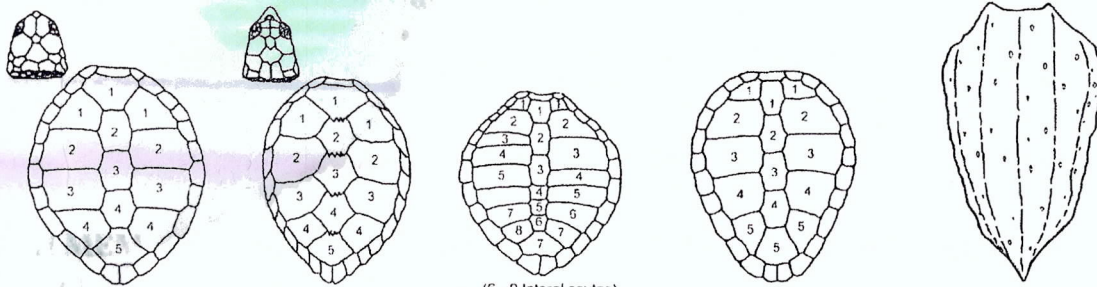
