Please be informed that the PAMO-RIWS staff together with the DENR Narra Sub-station personnel and on-the-job trainee's student from Western Philippines University conducted coastal clean-up activity at Linda Island, Bgy. Caguisan, Narra, Palawan on July 29, 2022 in coordination with the Barangay Local Government Unit. The said activity was in compliance to the PAMO-RIWS 2nd direct activity under Coastal and Marine Ecosystems Rehabilitation Sub-Program/Management of Coastal and Marine Resources/Areas for FY 2022.

A total of 10 sacks of garbage was collected during the clean-up activity of which most are composed of plastic bottles, styrofoams, plastic wraps, used nylons and ropes. Aside from the sea current that brings garbage debris in the island, unregulated anthropogenic activity and their improper waste disposal when visiting the island also contributes to littering in the area.

The activity started at 9:00 o'clock in the morning, successfully ended before lunch time. The garbage collected was brought back by the BLGU officials and participants for proper disposal.


