This pertain to the verbal instruction for this office to give justification on why the six hundred thousand (600,000.00) pesos intended for the renovation/repair of the various building within the jurisdiction of CENRO Taytay is not yet utilized.

The Regional Office requires us to submit Scope of Work for major repair/rehabilitation of building and other structures compliant to the latest standard and costing set by the Department of Public Works and Highways. The work requires expertise of a registered Civil Engineer. Our office has no available registered Civil Engineer, so we ask assistance to the PENRO dated January 19, 2022 and letter to DPWH dated March 4, 2022 but no avail.

We are force to hire a private License Civil Engineer last March, fifteen days after the letter to DPWH to do for the job description required. The inspection of the damage establishment was conducted on the same month but the report was just submitted by the concern Civil Engineer on the month of May or two months after the inspection.
