Submitted is the report of CENRO Roxas on the turn-over of Philippine Long-Tailed Macaque (*Macaca fascicularis philippensis*) within their custody.

Based on the report, the said species was turned-over by Mr. Jetro Marquez of Barangay Poblacion, Bansud, Oriental Mindoro on August 19, 2022. It was domesticated at first by the sender but due to its aggressiveness upon growth and being harmful to the residence, it was decided to be entrusted to CENRO Roxas. Upon turn over, it was examined and observed to have simple wound and curable. It is now in the Wildlife Rescue Center in Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro for safe keeping and monitoring, before its release back into the wild.



Respectfully submitted the report of wildlife species turned over to CENRO Roxas, Oriental Mindoro.


One (1) Philippine long-tailed macaque (*Macaca fascicularis philippensis*) or commonly known as “unggoy” were turned over to CENRO Roxas, Oriental Mindoro. It was hand over by Mr. Jetro Marquez, residence of Barangay Poblacion, Bansud, Oriental Mindoro on August 19, 2022 at 1:00 in the afternoon. According to Mr. Marquez the said species was given to him as a gift by a friend last September 10, 2020 from Puerto Galera, Oriental Mindoro. It was probably 7 to 8 months old on that time, he decided to turn it over to the CENRO Office because the wildlife species were already aggressive that is harmful to the residence. The CENRO Personnel successfully rescued the wildlife species. It was observed that the species has its wound in its belly due to the rope that was tangled to it. It is now under the custody of Wildlife Rescue Center for rehabilitation and monitoring before it will be release back into the wild.
