REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION RE: LETTER DATED MAY 11,

2022 OF ATTY. JANSEN I. JONTILLA, PROVINCIAL OFFICER

OF NCIP PALAWAN PROVINCIAL OFFICE.

COMMENT

This has reference to the letter dated May 11, 2022 of Atty. Jansen I. Jontilla, Provincial Officer of NCIP Palawan Provincial Office requesting for the following documents in order to facilitate the issuance of NCIP Clearance of Ms. Yara and Mr. De Vera on their public land application:

- 1. Complete set of the application and attachments;
- 2. Approved land survey; and
- 3. Other documents to prove their claim and/or occupation of the said area.

Accordingly, these documents will be used during the investigation and field validation, considering that the applied area is part of the ancestral domain claim of the Tagbanua with Petition No. R04-PAL-0005-AD, covering the Barangays of Napsan, Bagong Bayan and Simpocan, Puerto Princesa City, which has been approved by the NCIP Commission En Banc.

Particularly, the comment of the undersigned is sought on the following:

- 1. Whether CENRO Puerto Princesa City may provide the above-mentioned requested documents to the NCIP and
- 2. Is it necessary to provide the above-mentioned documents to the NCIP for them to determine whether or not to issue the NCIP clearance?

The CENRO Puerto Princesa City has the discretion whether or not to allow the disclosure of the above-mentioned documents to the NCIP for the issuance of Certification pursuant to the provisions of DENR Administrative Order No. 2016-29 or otherwise known as the DENR Freedom of Information Manual. Under Item II of the said administrative order, the determination of the applicability of any of the exceptions to the request shall be the responsibility of the Decision Maker (CENRO or his/her duly authorized representative) who shall be in control of the information, public record, or official record. Hence, the CENRO or his authorized representative must determine whether the requested documents are not included in

any of the exceptions listed under Annex "C" and/or not a sensitive personal information for them to be able to provide the said documents.

Anent the second issue on whether it is necessary to provide the above-mentioned documents to the NCIP for them to determine whether or not to issue the NCIP clearance, the undersigned opines that it is not necessary for the NCIP to secure the complete set of application requirements and attachments and other documents to prove the applicant's claim and/or occupation of the said area. However, the information regarding the boundaries in the approved land survey is vital in determining whether the area of CADT is within the boundaries applied for by applicants, Ms. Yara and Mr. De Vera.

To give an overview, Section 13 of Joint DAR-DENR-LRA-NCIP Administrative Order No. 01-12 provides for the mechanisms to prevent and resolve contentious areas/issues between the NCIP, DENR and DAR, to wit:

SECTION 13. Projection of Survey Plans. — The need for improving standards and processing of survey plans among agencies is hereby recognized as a critical step to minimize occurrence of overlaps. As such, all survey plans processed by NCIP, DAR and DENR shall be in accordance with the Manual of Land Surveys in the Philippines.

Prior to the approval by the NCIP of the CADT/CALT application, the NCIP shall furnish DAR (Regional Office which in turn will endorse to the Provincial Office for the issuance of the necessary certification or recommendation), DENR and LRA a copy of the original survey plan for projection and verification in order to determine if the AD/AL survey overlaps with titled properties and other approved surveys on file. In the absence of a technical problem, the DENR, DAR and LRA have thirty (30) days from receipt of the AD/AL survey plan within which to return the same to NCIP, together with the required certification or their findings and recommendations, as the case may be.

Should there be overlapping of titled properties or approved survey plans within the AD/AL as determined by the LRA, DENR and DAR, an endorsement or certification to that effect shall be issued by the LRA (Central Office), DENR (Regional LMS) and DAR (Province/s which shall copy furnish the Regional Office and the Assistant Secretary for Operations) stating therein the specific details, such as, the approved survey number and/or title number of the titled properties overlapped by the AD/AL survey. Approved survey plans as used in this Joint Administrative Order refers to approved surveys prior to October 29, 1997. Thereafter, the said survey plan together with endorsements or certifications shall be returned to the NCIP for segregation/exclusion of such titled properties or approved survey plans from the survey plan and the technical description of the AD/AL. For this purpose, it shall be the primary duty and responsibility of the NCIP to secure all necessary data to be used as reference in the segregation/exclusion process.

It is equally the responsibility of DAR and DENR to furnish the NCIP the survey data pertinent to the application on process, free of charge.

The original AD/AL survey plan, as amended, shall then be submitted to the LRA, DENR and DAR anew for final projection. The LRA, DENR and DAR have fifteen (15) days from receipt of the AD/AL amended survey plan within which to return the same to NCIP and to issue the certification of non-overlap with titled properties and over those lands which have proofs of prior vested rights subject to extension if meritorious circumstances warrant.

In case there is overlapping with any proclamation, reservation or any other similar issuances, the endorsement herein above-mentioned shall likewise contain such findings to enable the NCIP to comply with the provisions of Paragraph 13 of Joint LRA-NCIP Memorandum Circular No. 1, series of 2007 which states:

"Section 13. Where the Ancestral Domain or Ancestral Land is overlapped by any proclamation or reservation, the area covered by the said proclamation shall be so indicated in the survey plan.

The certification to be issued by the NCIP showing that it has complied with Sec. 52 (i) of R.A. No. 8371 and the Resolution of the Commission approving the CADT/CALT shall form part of the documents to be submitted to LRA as basis for the issuance of the appropriate authority to register."

Conversely, DAR and DENR shall, before processing or further processing applications for land titles pursuant to their respective mandates involving conflict areas (i.e., identified by the agencies concerned with pending/overlapping jurisdictional/operational issues or conflicting claims which are contentious or potentially contentious), must notify NCIP of the specific area to be titled and the latter shall certify, subject to the provisions of this section on projection of survey plans and issuance of certification of non-overlap, whether the same affects an AD or AL.

xxx"

The said provision requires the NCIP to provide the original survey plan for projection and verification to the DENR or DAR before the NCIP may approve the CADT/CALT. Meaning to say, before the subject area may be given an approved CADT/CALT, the NCIP must segregate all the titled properties and approved survey plans. If there is no technical problem and overlapping of boundaries, the DENR or DAR shall issue a certificate of non-overlap. However, if there is an overlapping of titled properties/approved survey plans to the AD/AL being claimed, the DENR or DAR must endorse a certification (stating therein the specific details, such as, the approved survey number and/or title number of the titled properties overlapped by the AD/AL survey) to the NCIP for exclusion or segregation. The NCIP shall then amend the original AD/AL survey plan to be submitted to the DENR or DAR for final projection. The DENR or DAR

shall return the same and issue a certificate of non-overlap. This is in consonance with Section 56 of Republic Act No. 8371 or otherwise known as "The Indigenous Peoples' Rights Act of 1997" recognizes the existing prior and vested rights within the ancestral land/domain, to wit:

SECTION 56. Existing Property Rights Regimes. — Property rights within the ancestral domains already existing and/or vested upon effectivity of this Act, shall be recognized and respected.

Note, however, that the titled properties and approved survey plans pertain to those that were approved prior to the enactment of the IPRA law (October 29, 1997). These properties are allowed to be segregated and/or excluded to the AD/AL survey plan.

In addition, the statement above that "it shall be the primary duty and responsibility of the NCIP to secure all necessary data to be used as reference in the segregation/exclusion process. It is equally the responsibility of DAR and DENR to furnish the NCIP the survey data pertinent to the application on process, free of charge." pertains only for the purpose of segregating and/ or excluding the titled properties or approved survey plans from the survey plan and the technical description of the AD/AL and not to the issuance of Certification whether the same affects AD/AL. Here, the NCIP is requesting for the complete set of application and attachments and other documents to prove the claim of the applicant, however, what the applicants are requesting to the NCIP is the Certification to the effect whether or not the area to be titled is within the CADT and not for the purpose of segregation/exclusion of the subject area. The NCIP can just furnish the said Certification even without reference to the complete set of application and attachments and other documents to prove the claim of the applicant. What the NCIP needs to determine whether or not the area to be titled affects the AD/AL is the technical description in the approved survey plan of the applicants for them to determine whether it is within the bounds of the area claimed as AD/AL.

Further, the notification requirement under Section 13 of the said joint administrative order means that the CADT had undergone the requirement of projection of survey plan and certificate of non-overlap issued by the DENR or DAR. Meaning to say, the basis of the NCIP to certify whether the area to be titled is within the AD/AL should be the area projected from the approved CADT/CALT which have already undergone the requirement of projection or survey and certificate of non-overlap.

In the case of Loloy Unduran et. al. vs. Ramon Aberasturi et. al¹, the Supreme Court recognized the Joint *DAR-DENR-LRA-NCIP* Administrative Order No. 01, Series of 2012 and held that:

"On the other hand, the DAR and DENR shall not process titles pursuant to their mandate on lands certified by NCIP as ancestral domain or ancestral lands except in areas with prior and vested rights. Provided, however, that the certification by NCIP on lands as Ancestral Domains or Ancestral Lands pursuant to Section 52(i) of IPRA presupposes that the provision of Section 13 hereof on the projection of survey plans and issuance of Certification of Non-Overlap have already been complied with."

It is very clear and mandatory that DAR and DENR shall not process titles certified by NCIP as AD/AL except in areas with prior and vested rights. However, this is subject to the condition that the NCIP have complied with the provisions of Section 52 of IPRA and Section 13 of the Joint Administrative Order No. 01 series of 2012.

Here, there is already a notification of assumption of jurisdiction over ancestral domains sent by the NCIP to the Secretary of the DENR over CADT number R04-PUE-0913-161 covering Barangays Napsan, Bagon Bayan, Simpucan, portion of Barangay Bacungan and portion of Snake Island, Puerto Princesa City². Since the notification presupposes that all the requisites under Section 52 and Section 13 have been complied with, it is for the DENR to question the validity of the assumption of NCIP over the subject areas by proving non-compliance with the said provisions.

Considering the foregoing, the undersigned advises the DENR-PENRO Palawan to instruct the DENR-CENRO Puerto Princesa City to verify whether the requirement under Section 13 of the Joint Administrative Order on the projection of survey plan and certificate of non-overlap were complied with by the NCIP prior to the approval of CADT number R04-PUE-0913-161 covering Barangays Napsan, Bagon Bayan, Simpucan, portion of Barangay Bacungan and portion of Snake Island, Puerto Princesa City. The DENR-CENRO Puerto Princesa City may furnish the technical description of the approved survey plan or the copy of the approved survey plan itself for the NCIP to determine whether the area to be titled is within the CADT being claimed by the IPs.

In the meantime, the DENR-CENRO Puerto Princesa City should not process Ms. Yara and Mr. De Vera's application for land titling pending the certification to be issued by the NCIP on whether the area to be titled is within the area covered under CADT number R04-PUE-0913-161. If the approved survey plan of Ms. Yara and Mr. De Vera already existed prior to October 29, 1997, the DENR CENRO Puerto Princesa City must endorse the approved survey plan for segregation and/or exclusion by the NCIP in accordance with Section 13 of the said Joint Administrative Order.

The undersigned likewise advises the DENR-PENRO Palawan to forward the CENRO Puerto Princesa City's request for clarification to the DENR MIMAROPA Region and to the DENR CENTRAL Office since this involves interpretation of law and to determine whether there has been an ongoing negotiation or talks entered into by the DENR, DAR, LRA and NCIP regarding the matter.

Subject: Notification of assumption of jurisdiction over ancestral domains

Paragraph (i), Section 52, Chapter VIII of Republic Act 8371, otherwise known as the Indigenous Peoples Rights Act of 1997 (IPRA) provides, as follows:

"i.) Turnover of Areas within Ancestral Domains managed by other Government Agencies. The Chairperson of the NCIP shall certify that the area covered is an ancestral domain. The secretaries of the Department of Agrarian Reform, Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Department of Interior and Local Government, and Department of Justice, the Commissioner of the National Development Corporation, and any other government agency claiming jurisdiction over the area shall be notified thereof. Such notification shall terminate any legal basis for the jurisdiction previously claimed."

The following areas, after thorough scruiny by this Commission of the documents comprising the claim book of the CADT Applicant/s, are found to be held under a claim of ownership, occupied and possessed by the Indigenous Peoples/Indigenous Cultural Communities since time immemorial up to the present and issued Certificate of Ancestral domain Title (CADT), viz:



11, 2022 OF ATTY. JANSEN I. JONTILA, PROVINCIAL OFFICER OF NCIP PALAWAN PROVINCIAL OFFICE IN RELATION TO SECTION 5 OF DMC 2019-10 DATED

DECEMBER 11, 2019

This pertains to the letter dated May 11, 2022 from Atty. Jansen I. Jontila, Provincial Officer of NCIP Palawan, in relation to the letter of this Office dated May 5, 2022, which is in compliance to Section 5 of DMC 2019-10 dated December 11, 2019 re: Applicability of Joint Administrative Order No. 1, Series of 2012, which states that "In cases where the land falls under Ancestral Domain/Lands, the provision under Section 13, Article V of JAO No. 1 is adopted to minimize occurrence of overlaps with the jurisdiction of DENR, LRA, DAR, and NCIP."

Section 13, Article V of JAO No. 1 states that "xxx Conversely, DAR and DENR shall, before processing or further processing applications for land titles pursuant to their respective mandates involving conflict areas (i.e., identified by the agencies concerned with pending/overlapping jurisdictional/operational issues or conflicting claims which are contentious or potentially contentious), must notify NCIP of the specific area to be titled and the latter shall certify, subject to the provisions of this section on projection of survey plans and issuance of certification of non-overlap, whether the same affects an AD or AL.xxx."

According to the letter of Atty. Jontilla, their Office will be needing the following documents in order to facilitate the issuance of the requested NCIP Clearance/Certification, to wit:

- 1. Complete set of the application and the attachments;
- 2. Approved land survey; and
- 3. Other documents to prove their claim and/or occupation of the said area.

Consequently, the said documents will be used during investigation and field validation considering that the applied area is part of the Ancestral Domain claim of the Tagbanua with Petition No. R04-PAL-0005-AD, covering the Barangays of Napsan, Bagong Bayan and Simpocan, Puerto Princesa City, and has been approved by the NCIP Commission En Banc, hence, requesting the Office to inform the applicants, **both previous and future applicants, including schools**, regarding these requirements to coordinate with the NCIP Office.

Be informed that the Barangays of Napsan, Bagong Bayan, Simpocan and portion of Bacungan (Tagkawayan), all in Puerto Princesa City are covered with a **Notification of Assumption of Jurisdiction** per letter dated November 24, 2017 of the Chairperson of NCIP, Atty. Leonor T. Oralde-Quintayo to then DENR Secretary Roy A. Cimatu **NOTIFYING OF ASSUMPTION OF JURISDICTION OF NCIP OVER ANCESTRAL LANDS** covering the aforementioned areas issued with CADT pursuant to paragraph (i), Section 52, Chapter VIII of Republic Act 8371, otherwise known as the Indigenous Peoples Rights Act of 1997 (IPRA).

However, a Legal Opinion dated February 28, 2020 was issued by the Director of the Legal Affairs Service, Atty. Norlito A. Eneran, L.L.M. CESO III, concurring with the opinion of then Palawan Provincial Officer Roldan V. Parangue that the DENR still has jurisdiction to issue patents over applications involving areas covered by CADT No. R04-PUE-0913-161, and to hear and decide land disputes involving alienable and disposable lands falling within the said CADT.

In view of the aforementioned circumstances, this Office is requesting a CLEARANCE and/or CLARIFICATION whether the requested documents (items 1 to 3), which may or may not lead to the issuance of an NCIP Clearance can be all provided to the NCIP.

For your information, issuance of clarification and advise of action.

REQUEST FOR LEGAL OPINION/CLARIFICATION RE: CADT NO. RO4-PUE-0913-161, AND LETTER DATED MARCH 6, 2019 OF ENGR. ROLDAN G. PARANGUE, NCIP FIELD OFFICER-PALAWAN, RELATIVE TO THE CLAIM OF NAPSAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL

This pertains to your request for legal opinion on whether your Office has jurisdiction to issue patents over applications involving areas covered by Certificate of Ancestral Domain Title (CADT) No. RO4-PUE-0913-161, and to hear and decide land disputes involving agricultural areas falling within the said CADT.

Your inquiry is anchored on a letter from the Palawan Provincial Officer dated 06 March 2019 and addressed to the Community Environment and Natural Resources (CENR) Officer stating that your Office still has jurisdiction to resolve the conflict between Napsan National High School and a certain Rolando Medel over that parcel of land covered by the subject CADT.

After a careful review of existing laws and jurisprudence, we opine that your Office still has jurisdiction to issue patents over applications involving areas covered by the aforementioned CADTs as well as to adjudicate disputes involving agricultural areas falling within the same.

From the letter of the Palawan Provincial Officer, it is clear that although the National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP) approved the application for the issuance of CADT, registration of the same has not yet been completed as certain procedures prior to its registration have not been complied with. Thus, the CADT has not actually been issued.

Given that no actual CADT has been issued, the lot subject of the controversy remains alienable public land under the jurisdiction of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) as per Executive Order No. 192, Series of 1987, which states that:

Section 5. Powers and Functions. To accomplish its mandate, the Department shall have the following powers and functions: DENN R 3V

"Grow a tree for legacy"

(d) Exercise supervision and control over forest lands, alienable and disposable lands, and mineral resources and in the process of exercising such control the Department shall impose appropriate payments, fees, charges, rentals and any such form of levy and collect such revenues for the exploration, development, utilization or gathering of such resources;

The NCIP assumed jurisdiction only over the application for issuance of CADT of the Tagbanuas of Napsan, Bagong Bayan and Simpucan, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan. After the approval of the same, but because of failure to immediately register the approved CADT application, the NCIP lost its jurisdiction.

Republic Act (RA) No. 8371 or the Indigenous People's Rights Act of 1997 is very clear as to the jurisdiction of the NCIP. Section 66 thereof explicitly states that:

Section 66. Jurisdiction of the NCIP. — The NCIP, through its regional offices, shall have jurisdiction over all claims and disputes involving rights of ICCs/IPs: Provided, however, That no such dispute shall be brought to the NCIP unless the parties have exhausted all remedies provided under their customary laws. For this purpose, a certification shall be issued by the Council of Elders/Leaders who participated in the attempt to settle the dispute that the same has not been resolved, which certification shall be a condition precedent to the filing of a petition with the NCIP.

The Supreme Court, in the case of *Loloy Unduran*, et al. vs. Ramon Aberasturi[†], et al., has interpreted Section 66 of RA No. 8371 to mean that the jurisdiction of the NCIP is limited to actions wherein both parties are members of the same Indigenous Cultural Communities/Indigenous Peoples. Thus:

Therefore, pursuant to Section 66 of the IPRA, the NCIP shall have jurisdiction over claims and disputes involving rights of ICCs/IPs only when they arise between or among parties belonging to the same ICC/IP. When such claims and disputes arise between or among parties who do not belong to the same ICC/IP, i.e., parties belonging to different ICC/IPs or where one of the parties is a non-ICC/IP, the case shall fall under the jurisdiction of the proper Courts of Justice, instead of the NCIP.

Furthermore, the NCIP has expressed its intention to withdraw from Joint DAR-DENR-LRA-NCIP Administrative Order No. 01, Series of 2012². Thus, the position that the land subject of this controversy still falls under the jurisdiction of the NCIP no longer holds water. Absent any showing that the NCIP has jurisdiction, the presumption that the DENR has jurisdiction over all alienable and disposable lands of the public domain stands.
