

AUTHORIZING THE PARTICIPATION OF THE FOLLOWING DENR PERSONNEL IN MARINE RESOURCES ASSESSMENT AND MONITORING FOR DRY SEASON 2022 IN SNAKE ISLAND NCMCR ON APRIL 4-8, 2022

In line with the annual monitoring and assessment of the coastal and marine resources such as mangroves, seagrass, coral, fish assemblages, and avian community within Snake Island and as well as to conduct damage assessment caused by Typhoon Odette last December 17, 2021 at Snake Island – National Coastal and Marine Center for Research, the Snake Island Management Office (SIMO) initially assessed the damaged mangroves and corals in Snake Island with an estimated area of 3.5 hectares damaged/felled mangroves and out of 1,75 hectares of snorkeled area, around 75% were damaged. As advised by ERDB and BMB, to have a quantitative comparison of the status of the said ecosystem, before and after Typhoon, it is recommended to assess the established permanent stations for both mangroves and coral reefs.
