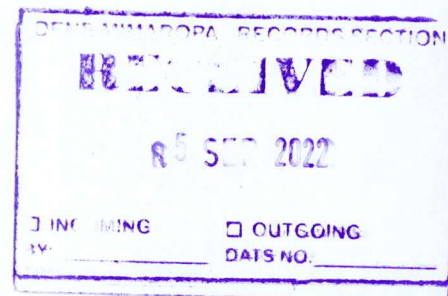

Respectfully forwarded is the memorandum dated August 15, 2022 of Conservation and Development Section (CDS) regarding the indo-pacific crocodile population survey and Communication, Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) at Malitub River, Barangay Malitub, Bataraza, Palawan serves as **Means of Verification (MOV)** to the target activity under protection and conservation of wildlife – the conduct of crocodile population survey for CY 2022.

Please be informed that the said activity was conducted on August 11-12, 2022, spearheaded by this office in partnership with the Palawan Wildlife Rescue and Conservation Center (PWRCC), Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD) and CENRO Brooke's Point. A total of one (1) head of Indo-Pacific Crocodile was spotted at Malitub River with an estimated length of 10-12 feet. The Communication, Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) was conducted on August 12, 2022 at the covered court of the aforementioned barangay participated by twenty-nine (29) individuals composed of 19 males and 10 females.

It is recommended to provide and install warning signage at Malitub River to remind the community as well as the visitors about the presence of Indo-Pacific crocodile in the area.

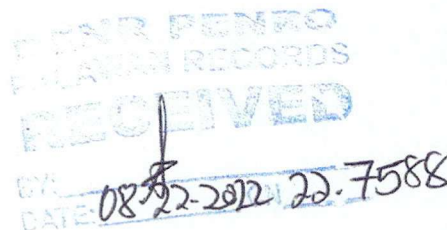

SUBJECT : **REPORT ON THE CONDUCTED CROCODILE POPULATION SURVEY AND COMMUNICATION, EDUCATION AND PUBLIC AWARENESS (CEPA) AT BARANGAY MALITUB, BATARAZA, PALAWAN**



This pertains to the target activity under Protection and Conservation of Wildlife-the Conduct of Crocodile Population Survey for 2022.

This Office created a team composed of representatives from the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office (PENRO), Community Environment and Natural Resources Office (CENRO), Palawan Council for Sustainable Development Staff (PCSDS), Barangay-Local Government Unit and the Palawan Wildlife Rescue and Conservation Center (PWRCC) that leads the activity.

The following are the lineup activities to be done that was presented to the LGU Malitub before its actual implementation;

1. Coordination with the respective LGUs (Municipal/Barangay) regarding the activities;
2. The conduct of Communication, Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) campaign regarding the Indo-Pacific Crocodile and
3. Crocodile population survey and mapping of its habitat range at barangay Malitub, Bataraza, Palawan.

On the early morning of August 11, 2022 the organized team proceeded to Barangay Malitub, Bataraza, Palawan. Had a courtesy call with Bgy. Kagawad Noria Gonzaga, the In Charge of the Day during that time. The team explained the plans and activities that will be conducted in their barangay. During the discussion, Kgd Gonzaga mentioned that there was an incident of human-crocodile conflict in their area last 2019. Accordingly, the body of the victim was found 3 to 4 days after the incident, floating in the river with his right arm detached from his body and nowhere to found. His buttocks had traces of bite and internal organs were not intact during the time of retrieval. In response to this report, the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development Staff (PCSDS) together with the Palawan Wildlife Rescue and Conservation Center (PWRCC) staff conducted an Information, Education and Communication (IEC) campaign on that same year in response to the incident and after receiving the report on Human-Crocodile conflict in the area.

The Barangay Hall and Elementary school are both located 50 meters away from the river where the crocodile is frequently seen. There are communities near the river as well. According to the family of the victim, the crocodile was observed in front of the docking area for a week after the incident. For the community, their interpretation on this gesture was that the crocodile was guilty of the incident and ready to accept the judgement of the community particularly the family

of the victim. But in response, the community just let the crocodile's presence in the area until it was gone after a week.

The team decided to conduct the river transect cruise and crocodile spotting the next day at 4:30 in the morning considering that it was high tide on that time. During the roving, the team spotted an adult crocodile with an estimated length of 10-12 feet long. Several basking areas were also observed during the roving. It was observed that the mangrove area of Barangay Malitub is in good condition. However, according to Kgwd. Gonzaga, there are some trespassers from the adjacent barangay who are doing illegal activities within the mangrove areas on the same location. The exploration ended in Bucana, which serves as the end point of assessment. Malitub River has a distance of approximately 2.44 kilometers.

On that same day at 10:00 in the morning, the team conducted Community, Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) at the covered court of Barangay Malitub. A total of twenty-nine (29) individuals participated in the activity. It was breakdown as follows; 19 males and 10 females.

Topics presented include *Republic Act 9147 or the Wildlife Act* by Ms. Ana Maria Acosta of Palawan Council for Sustainable Development Staff, *Kaalaman tungkol sa Buwaya* by Ms. Deseree Abalo of Palawan Wildlife Rescue and Conservation Center and other Mitigating Measures to Address Human – Crocodile Conflict by Mr. Salvador Guion of Palawan Wildlife Rescue and Conservation Center.

The undersigned recommended the provision and installation of warning signage in the river and other strategic areas where crocodiles are always observed within Barangay Malitub area in order to remind the community as well as visitors about the presence of Indo-Pacific crocodile in the area.

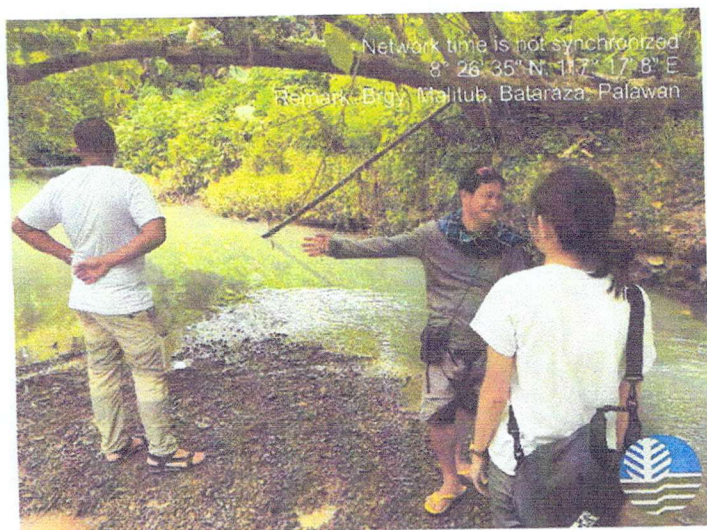

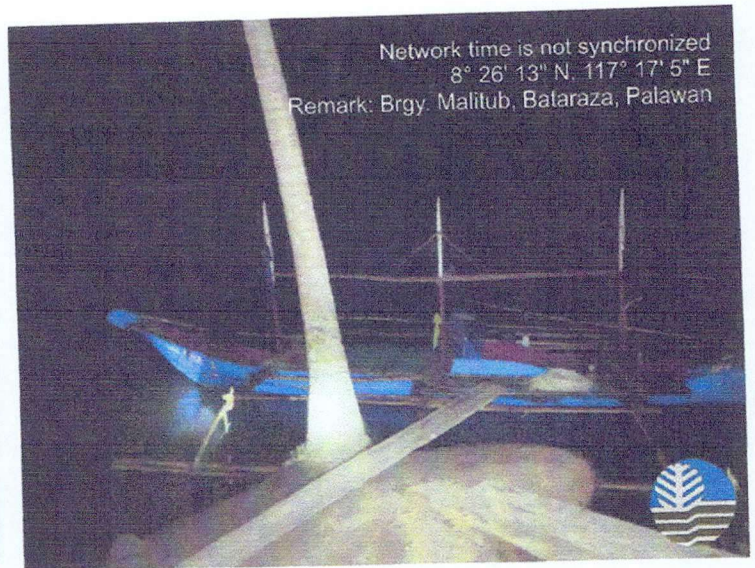

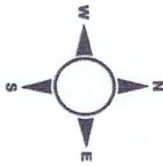

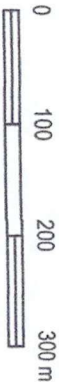
