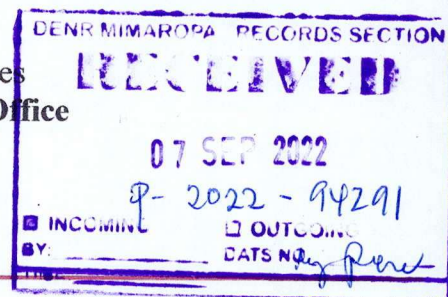





On May 17, 2022, the CBFM Staff conducted monitoring and based on the report there were additional 100 seeds planted which totaled 91.25% accomplishment. The PO likewise reminded that they should have to finish their project this August.

Respectfully submitting is the report of the undersigned on the monitoring of CBFM-CARP 2018 project for the 2nd quarter of Liminangcong Forest Management Association conducted on May 17, 2022 at Sitio Tulduan, Barangay Liminangcong Taytay, Palawan.

The activity disclosed the monitoring of the CBFM-CARP project awarded to LIFMA members located at Barangay Liminangcong, Taytay, Palawan which findings and observations are hereby enumerated as follows:

1. That pursuant to the Executive Order No. 263 adopting Community-Based Forest Management Program (CBFM) as national strategy to ensure the sustainable development of the country's forestland, gave a positive response to address poverty and ensure sustainable management of resources. This was strengthened by the issuance of Executive Order No. 318 known as "Sustainable Forest Management", Executive Order No. 606 known as "Sustainable Upland Development" which anchoring on food, wood and non-wood security and economic productivity. Further enhanced with Executive Order No. 616 known as "The Creation of the Anti-hunger Task Force" to address hunger both on the aspect of supply and demand for food for the upland dwellers, in particular.
2. The said program has been extended to LIFMA and became one of the beneficiaries resulted to the issuance of the CBFM Agreement No. 03-39 covering an area of 4,149 hectares on December 29, 2003. However, after the issuance of the instrument, the CBFM-PO became inactive due to issues in their organization and other members had relocated to other areas of the province. Nevertheless, on November 24, 2017, the said PO has been reactivated.

3. In 2018, the reactivated PO had acquired the CBFM-CARP 2018 project entitled "Fuel Wood with Orchard Plantation Project" with a total area of 100 hectares wherein various commodities such as Ipil-ipil, Kakawati, Gmelina, Narra, Ipil, Calamansi, Cacao, Guyabano, Coffee, Banana with pineapple, Jackfruit, Dragon fruits, corn and assorted vegetable crops had been proposed for plantation.
4. That the said PO had conducted various activities stipulated in the work and financial plan, however, it was not yet finished because the re-planting of some commodities affected by the El Nino and planting of some seedlings were hampered by the restrictions imposed because of the outbreak of the Covid-19 pandemic started from May 2020.
5. This Office did not fail to remind the PO through their president over text, phone calls and meetings to double their time in replacing such commodities and to finish the said project. A "Sinumpaang Pangako" has been signed by LIFMA President Nonita Bibat that stated to complete the planting and re-planting activity on December 15, 2020 for they have enough fund for the said project. However, the people's organization was not able to attain their commitments to complete the 100% planting. Yet, Mrs. Nonita Bibat, recommitted to complete the plantation area on rainy season.
6. In 2021, the PO reported that they're able to attain the 91% planting, however, the monitoring conducted for the whole year disclosed high mortality rate of the planted commodities because of El Nino and due to no maintenance and protection of the beneficiaries in the area, wherein, the PO was advised to make a way to replace the affected commodities on rainy season.
7. That on May 17, 2022, the CBFM Staff of this Office conducted the monitoring for the 2nd quarter particularly the planted commodities such as Banana intercropped with pineapple, Marcotted Calamansi, Cacao, Narra, Kakawate, Ipil, Ipil-ipil, Coffee and Jackfruit. The monitoring disclosed that the plantation areas are still unmaintained by the beneficiaries. Meanwhile, the PO has started planting particularly the Jackfruits (direct planting) in addition to the said commodity which was also affected by the summer season. There were about 100 pieces of seeds that had been planted during monitoring that totaled to 91.25% out of the 100 hectares target. On the other hand, the PO president mentioned that there were government officials who are willing to provide the assistance to their project. The undersigned encouraged them to maintain the coordination with the aforesaid officials in order to acquire assistance for the maintenance of their project. The PO likewise reminded that they should have to finish their project because the monitoring team from the Regional Office will conduct the monitoring this coming August, 2022.

8. That issues and concerns observed during monitoring are the following, to wit:

- Unmaintained plantations by the beneficiaries.
- The affected commodities by the summer season were not yet replaced.
- The bunkhouse is unmaintained even there is a caretaker installed by the PO president in the area.
- The PO president always committing for the completion of their project, however, until now the project has not been completed.

In view of the above issues and concerns, the undersigned hereby recommends the following, to wit:

1. The PO should have to finish their project this year; conduct re-planting on the affected commodities and maintain coordination with the PO members and beneficiaries on their plantations;
2. The PO should maintain their bunkhouse and establish the nursery to support the needs of the project in replacing the affected commodities.
3. The PO president should conduct meeting with the LIFMA Officers to tackle the problems encountered by the project.
4. The Office should have to hire the Monitoring and Evaluation Officer (MEO) to assist the PO in the area.
5. The Office should conduct meeting with the CBFM PO Officers together with the Punong Barangay and PENRO CBFM Focal Person to address the issues.

Please be informed further that this unit is currently organizing the overlapped shape files of the said project and we will submit it when finalized.

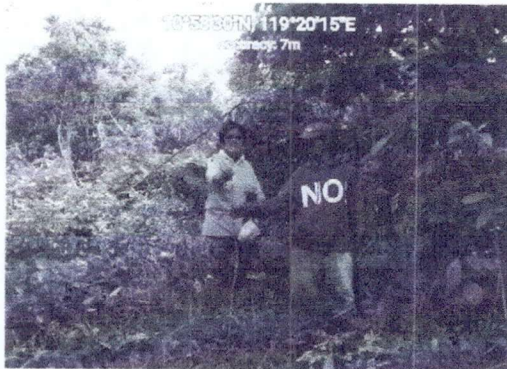

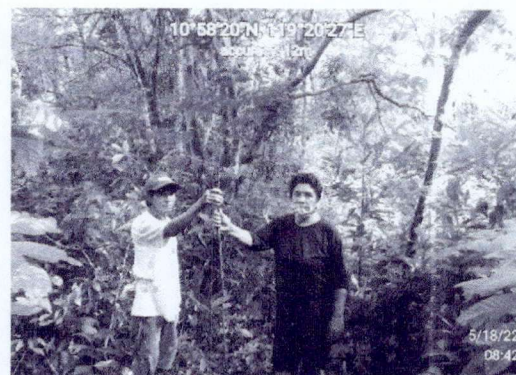

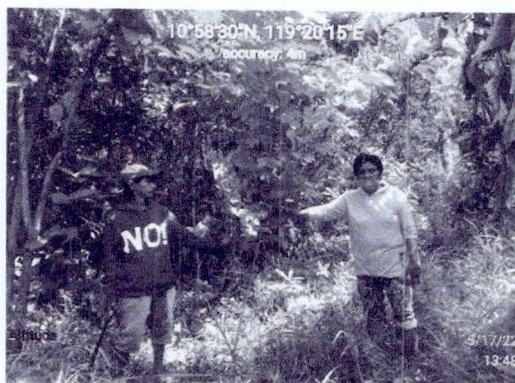
