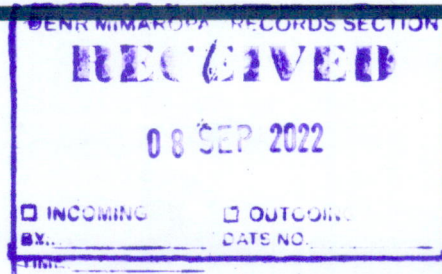

Furthermore, we would like to also request assistance on the following:


- Coordination with the Local Chief Executives (LCEs) for the courtesy call and orientation on the PASA initiative for VIP;
