This pertains to the Forest Land Use Agreement for Tourism Purposes (FLAgT No. R4B-10-2010) issued to Dos Palmas Island Resort and Spa represented by Ivy Michelle A. Lim located in Brgy. Manalo, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan.

Background

- The FLAgT of Dos Palmas Island Resort and Spa was issued on June 09, 2010 which covers a total of 24.00 hectares of forestland for bathing establishment.
- The computed Annual Government Share based on approved contract is Php 780,000.00. The holder already settled said amount on March 09, 2023 with Official Receipt No. 7132762 E.
- Based on the recent compliance monitoring report of PENRO Palawan disclosed that the Tourism Development Plan was not yet submitted, not all monuments are found within the boundaries of the approved FLAgT area, and some structures (concrete barrier and wharf) are constructed within the easement area.

Actions Taken

- On March 23, 2023, a Memorandum was issued by the Office of the OIC, ARD for Technical Services with instruction to PENRO and CENRO concerned to communicate with the FLAgT holder to address the findings and observations of the monitoring team.
- On the undated letter of OIC, CENRO Puerto Princesa City to Mr. Vincent Migallos, Duty Operations Manager, the latter was advised to comply and act appropriately on the findings and observations of the monitoring team.
- On May 08, 2023, the holder submitted a written explanation and justification, to wit:
 - a. The Tourism Development Plan will be submitted after the renovation of the resort and that they are currently working with DOT MIMAROPA for the approval of TDP that was prepared by the City Tourism;
 - b. All the monuments are reinstalled within the boundaries of FLAgT area witnessed and accepted by CENRO personnel; and

- c. The constructed wharf and concrete wall are within the approved FLAgT area. Both structures are not income generating, hence, the FLAgT holder appealed not to demolish said structures as these are protection measures of the beach.
- On the Memorandum dated July 05, 2023, the CENRO personnel verified that the constructed barrier and wharf is within the approved FLAgT area and was recommended to be considered in the interest of protection.

Recommendation

In view of the foregoing, it is respectfully recommended that the constructed concrete wall and wharf within the approved FLAgT and easement area shall be considered and exempted from self-demolition.

This refers to your letter dated 03 November 2023 requesting for the status of your tree cutting permit application filed in 2022.

Please be informed that said application is deemed disapproved by reason of the issuance of the attached Notice of Violation (NOV) dated February 3, 2023, signed by then OIC, PENR Officer Arnoldo A. Blaza, Jr., based on the results of monitoring conducted on January 18, 2023 by personnel of PENRO Romblon which disclosed that there were trees that were damaged and cleared within your exploration site without a duly-issued cutting permit. This disapproval, however, is without prejudice to the submission of a new application with corresponding requirements.

Further, the Joint Order dated February 6, 2023 signed by then Regional Executive Director Lormelyn E. Claudio, Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB) Regional Director Engr. Glenn Marcelo C. Noble, and Environmental Management Bureau (EMB) Regional Director Joe Amil M. Salino, which included the same NOV and the directive to file a case¹ for violation of Section 77 of PD 705, as amended, before the Office of the OIC, Provincial Prosecutor of Romblon, has already been elevated on appeal before the Office of the DENR Secretary.

Furthermore, as you are well aware of the requirements contained in DENR Administrative Order (DAO) No. 2021-11, please apprise us if said requirements in the previous application have been duly complied with prior to the issuance of the NOV.

FERNANDEZ/ARSOBISPA OCZON, APPELLANT, VERSUS HEIRS OF ANTONIO EDRADAN AND HEIRS OF ANICETO EDRADAN, REPRESENTED BY WILLIE PONCE DE LEON AND ERNESTO SAN JUAN, REPRESENTED BY JOHNNY FABELLO, APPELLEES"**

This refers to your Memorandum dated May 23, 2023 requesting for status of the reconstitution of patents in the above-cited case.

Please be informed that per Memorandum dated April 23, 2018 from then CENR Officer of Puerto Princesa City, Emer D. Garraez, the reconstitution of the said patents cannot be addressed by their office due to the lacking documentary references. They sought assistance regarding the following documents:

1. Lot Technical Descriptions or copy of F-Plans
2. Free Patent in judicial or copy form

Per Memorandum dated January 10, 2022, the Chief, TSD/Officer-in-Charge, the PENRO indorsed the Memorandum dated January 4, 2022 of then CENR Officer of Puerto Princesa City, Felizardo B. Cayatoc, stating that since the documentary requirements that would serve as reference in the reconstitution of patents were not available, the standing matter cannot be complied with. He likewise recommended the following:

1. Elevate the act of reconstitution to the Land Management Bureau considering that its original record and issuance is with the Bureau of Lands Central Office and/or
2. Request the amendment of DENR Order from Reconstitution to Re-Issuance of Patent.

Per Memorandum dated January 4, 2022, the CENR Officer of Puerto Princesa City also sought clarification if Cad. 800-D will be adopted as it will not coincide with other records that will be reconstituted, taking into account the order of the DENR Secretary on December 16, 2009 that the subject patent shall be reconstituted in the *"SAME FORM as they were when the loss or destruction occurred."* Further, they also inquired whether the reconstitution of the lacking documents shall be done and consequently signed by the current PENRO.

In the Certification dated August 08, 2022, the Chief, Land Records Section, Surveys and Mapping Division (SMD), it was stated that it appears that plans F-6281 and F-62480, both situated

in the City of Puerto Princesa, Province of Palawan, were not available on file. She provided certified true copies of Cad. 800-D Module 2 Case 26 map, and lot data computation of Lot Nos. 2703 and 2704, Cad. 800-D, in the names of Antonio Edradan, and Aniceto Edradan, respectively.

Per Memorandum dated August 22, 2022, the OIC, Assistant Regional Director for Technical Services stated that upon perusal of the carpeta filed in the records of the Licenses, Patents and Deeds Division (LPDD), there was no judicial form attached to the said Free Patent.

Per Memorandum dated January 31, 2023, then Regional Executive Director Lormelyn E. Claudio reiterated that plans F-6281 and F-62480, both situated in the City of Puerto Princesa, Province of Palawan, were not available on file, and that there was no judicial form attached to the said Free Patent in the carpeta filed in the Licenses, Patents and Deeds Division (LPDD), and that under DAO No. 2022-10, the issuing authority for the reconstitution of agricultural free patents of areas below five (5) hectares is the PENR Officer. Consequently, this Memorandum was referred to the CENR Officer, Puerto Princesa City on April 24, 2023.

Per Memorandum dated May 25, 2023, Planning Officer III/OIC-Chief, MSD, PENRO Palawan requested for clarification of the approved technical description of Lot Nos. 2703 and 2704, Cad. 800-D.

Per Memorandum dated August 1, 2023, the OIC, Assistant Regional Director for Technical Services forwarded to the PENR Officer, Palawan the corrected lot data computation of Lot Nos. 2703 and 2704, Cad. 800-D based on the Amendment Order No. 0584-2023 issued by the Chief, Surveys and Mapping Division.

**ADDITIONAL TERMS, CONDITIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS UNDER THE
GRATUITOUS SPECIAL USE PERMIT**

1. The area granted in this Permit: (a) is a public forest land based on existing records; (b) shall not be involved in any private transaction.
2. The annual government share or user's fee is waived in favor of the **Permittee**.
3. The **Permittee** shall: (a) comply with the laws, rules and regulations and instructions now or hereinafter enforced for the proper use of the land; (b) respect any legal or prior claims; (c) conserve the corners and boundary lines of the area; (d) protect any wetlands such as spring, waterfalls, peatlands, swamps, lake and marshes or natural/historical/archaeological sites in the area; (e) report to the nearest local forest officer(s) all forest violations in the area and adjacent lands; and (f) submit a year-end report, not later than March 30 of the succeeding year, to the concerned Regional Executive Director thru the CENRO/PENRO the kind, number and value of improvement(s) introduced in the area, among others.
4. The **Permittee** shall: (a) not appropriate for himself/herself the exclusive use of public trails traversing or adjoining the area or impede the use thereof by the public; (b) not sublease the area or any portion thereof; and (c) protect and conserve threatened, unique, rare and endangered trees/plants/wildlife identified under existing rules and regulations.
5. A separate permit shall be secured by the Permittee should tree cutting be necessary. However, no tree, regardless of species, shall be cut in the permitted area if found within forty (40) meters from banks of rivers, creeks or streams and buffer strips. In case the said 40-meter strip is bereft of trees, the same shall be rehabilitated by the **Permittee**.
6. The **Permittee** shall strictly observe the terms and conditions of the ECC. In case the Permittee will conduct periodic rehabilitation of the infrastructures or introduce new appurtenances within the GSUP area, the same shall secure an appropriate clearance from the EMB for the purpose and submit the clearance to the concerned DENR Regional Office prior to such undertakings therein.
7. The **Permittee** shall strictly observe sanitary measures within the permit area to ensure protection of watershed values.
8. The **Permittee** shall protect the permitted area from forest fires and other forms of forest destruction.

9. Non-use of the area within six (6) months after it is granted will result in the cancellation of the Permit except in cases of force majeure or fortuitous events.
10. In case the area no longer serves the purpose as warranted under the said Permit, the Permit shall be cancelled and the subsequent management and administration of the affected area shall be assumed by the DENR.
11. Violations or non-compliance of any of the terms and conditions of the Permit or any environment and natural resources management laws, policies, rules and regulations shall be sufficient grounds for the cancellation thereof without prejudice to whatever legal action that may be taken.
12. The GSUP for the construction of roads and bridges shall have a maximum non-renewable term of five (5) years and similarly, the GSUP for the construction and operation of schools, hospitals, health centers, flood control facilities, water reservoir or impounding dam and its related facilities, air strip, landing site, harbor, public market, public plazas and evacuations site shall have a maximum non-renewable term of five (5) years. The GSUP and its additional terms and conditions shall be approved by the RED.
13. Except the agencies permitted to construct roads and bridges, the other agencies permitted to construct and operate infrastructure projects or facilities for public service and use shall apply for the issuance of Presidential Proclamation starting on the second year from the issuance of the GSUP to ensure effective management and sustainability of the infrastructure and facilities and its long-term use of the area where the infrastructure exists.
14. Failure to secure a Presidential Proclamation within the allowable period starting from the second (2nd) year to the fifth (5th) year of the GSUP, the Permittee shall apply for Forest Land Use Agreement (FLAg) pursuant to DENR Administrative Order No. 2004-59 dated 31 August 2004 and other related policies on special uses of forest lands.

Respectfully submitted is the Memorandum dated September 11, 2023 of OIC, PENRO Occidental Mindoro regarding the above subject in compliance with the target under OO1: Natural Resources Conservation and Development Program: Protected Areas, Caves and Wetlands Development and Management Sub-program: I. Proclaimed and Legislated PAs: 4. PA Habitat Protection; A. Implementation of Biodiversity Monitoring System (BMS) within Mts. Iglit – Baco Natural Park (MIBNP) in Occidental Mindoro.

BMS was conducted using four (4) main methods: Transect Walk, Field Diary, Focus Group Discussion (FGD) and Photo Documentation.

1) Transect Walk

For this semester, transect walk was conducted from August 08-11, 2023. Shown in Table 1 is the summary of results in five (5) established transect routes: Site 1 - Dalipi Creek to Bayanan; Site 2 - Magawang to Nagbobong; Site 3 - Bulo Creek to Medalla Hill; Site 4 - Fokurato to Fangandatan; and Site 5 - Bayokbok to Iyan.

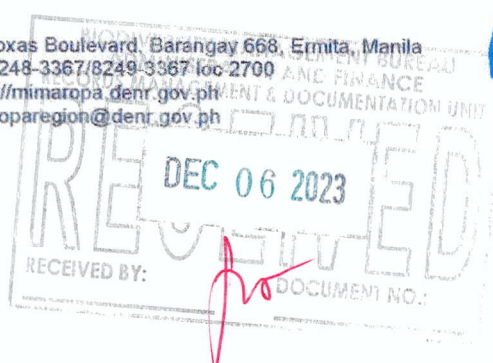

There were twenty one (21) participants from PAMO ENMRPA composed of seventeen (17) males, three (3) females and one (1) LGBTQIA while the lectures were provided by resource speakers from CENRO Taytay, PAMO ENMRPA, Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD), Provincial National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP) and El Nido Chamber of Commerce, Inc. (ENCCI).

The following topics were discussed based on the result (by order of priority) of the Training Needs Assessment (TNA) for PAMO Staff conducted in CY 2022:

In addition to the afore-cited topics, relevant supplementary topics were likewise discussed, such as *i)* Profile of ENMRPA, *ii)* Forestry laws with emphasis on the provisions and penalties under PD 705, *iii)* professionalism at workplace, and *iv)* RA 11313 (The Safe Space Act).

Moreover, the learning activity had engaged the participants in pre-test and post-test exercises as well as in relevant group workshops and subsequent presentation of outputs critiqued by the respective resource persons/facilitators. The workshop highlighted on "Threat Mapping and Enforcement Planning."

Accordingly, the workshop was successful as gauged from the results of the pre and post tests, workshop outputs and post learning insights. Thus, the PAMO ENMRPA concluded that similar learning activity is necessary to be conducted annually for new entrants in the PA and as refresher/re-learning ground for PAMO Staff/law enforcers.

BMS was conducted on July 03 to August 31, 2023 using four (4) main methods: Field Diary, Transect Walk, Photo Documentation and Focus Group Discussion (FGD).

1. FIELD DIARY

A total of 31 species of fauna were recorded during the conduct of field diary from July to August 2023. Four (4) of these species are considered as the priority species listed below:

A total of two hundred twenty-five (225) individuals composed of seven (7) important species were observed and recorded for the 2nd semester CY 2023. An increase in number of individuals and species was observed and recorded compared to the previous semester CY 2023. No signs of disturbance found during the monitoring activity within established transect line.

3. PHOTO DOCUMENTATION

Photo documentation was undertaken in Barangay Panacan I, Narra, Palawan on August 2023. There are no significant changes observed in the area compared to the previous semester.

4. FOCUS GROUP DISCUSSION (FGD)

Focus Group Discussion was conducted on August 18, 2023 in Barangay Panacan 2, Narra, Palawan. It was participated by ten (10) Community Monitoring Group (CMG) members. Dialogue was done among Barangay Purok officials, fisher folks, and PAMO staff. Issues on illegal fishing activity within the municipal waters of Narra, Palawan were raised during the conduct of the activity. Continuous monitoring and patrolling activities are conducted within RIWS.
