
This activity is based on the target of this office on technical assistance on MPAN for LGU managed MPAs.

**ACTIVITY REPORT ON THE 4th QUARTER
SABLAYAN-CALINTAAN MARINE PROTECTED AREA NETWORK
(SaCa MPAN) EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING**

I. BACKGROUND

Marine Protected Area Network (MPAN) is an aggregation of individual MPAs or reserves operating collectively and synergistically at various spatial scales, designed to meet objectives based on ecological, social, informational, and administrative considerations that a single reserve cannot achieve alone, while also linking people and institutions involved in a harmonized and holistic initiative to facilitate learning and coordination in planning and administration.

Marine Protected Areas (MPAs) have been employed as an important coastal resource management tool in the Philippines to respond to the growing threats to fishery production and marine biodiversity (Aliño et al. 2002). A growing number of empirical studies have shown the potential benefits of MPAs to fisheries have been done (e.g. Alcala and Russ 1990, Roberts et al. 2001, May et al. 2002, Abesamis et al. 2006). During the last few decades, the potential value of MPAs to protect rare and threatened species is slowly being recognized and applied (e.g. establishment of dugong sanctuaries) in the country.

The DENR MIMAROPA Region, the Provincial Government of Occidental Mindoro, and the municipalities of Sablayan and Calintaan agreed to form a cluster and collaborate within their common coastal ecosystem to maximize resources and the benefits that will be gained from the collaboration with the assistance of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources.

II. ACTIVITIES

a. MPAN Executive Committee Meeting

The SaCa MPAN Executive Committee in facilitation of CENRO Sablayan and PENRO Occidental Mindoro conducted the fourth quarter meeting at Bihag Hills Resort, New Dagupan, Calintaan, Occidental Mindoro on October 26, 2023.

The meeting began at 10:30 a.m. with a prayer from Mr. Christer D. Martos, followed by the singing of the National Anthem through an AVP. MENRO Delmer B. Garingalo of LGU Calintaan delivered the opening remarks. The secretariat ECOMS I Herold S. Castro from CENRO Sablayan facilitated roll call and proof of quorum.

ECOMS I Herold S. Castro presented the highlights of the aforementioned activity. The following are the topics, issues, and concerns that were discussed:

1. Approval of the Minutes of the Previous Meeting

The secretariat read the minutes of the previous meeting, which was held on September 12, 2023. After reading and incorporating the agreements with corrections, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved and subject to revision and improvement on the motion of Mr. Delmer B. Garingalo and seconded by Hon. Reynaldo P. Dormido, LGU Calintaan SB member.

2. Presentation of Accomplishments of the member agencies in relation to Coastal and Marine Ecosystem with their respective jurisdiction

Member agencies from Law Enforcement Units presented their individual accomplishments, beginning with the Philippine Coast-Guard Sablayan Sub-Station, presented by CG POI Michael John I. Tobias, followed by the Philippine Coast Guard San Jose Sub-Station, presented by CG POI Lyndon E. Dela Cruz. For Calintaan Municipal Police Station, PEMS Vangie Laubalyo, and PSSg Marie Anne Barolo highlighted their regular and participated activities such as tree planting, coastal clean-up, and patrolling activities within their respective jurisdiction. Mr. Alfonso A. Ero of MFARMC Calintaan and Mr. Ryan P. Acosta of MFARMC Sablayan, as well as Mr. Joselito A. Tiongson of MENRO Sablayan, also presented their regular activities, accomplishments, and future plans in relation to Coastal and Marine resources in LGU Calintaan and Sablayan, respectively.

3. Review of the Sa-Ca MPAN Memorandum of Agreement

The Sa-Ca MPAN MOA was signed on December 20, 2019. The MOA follows the R.A. policy. 8550, as amended by R.A. 10654 (Philippine Fisheries Code), RA 7160 (Local Government Code of 1991), and E.O. 533 (Integrated Coastal Management Strategy) that link/collaborate with other agencies, institutions, and organizations. The Executive Committee recommended to the secretariat to schedule a meeting with the Local Chief Executive of each municipality, pertaining to the content of the existing MOA and their opinion whether renew or retain the content and signatures of the said MOA.



4. Appointment for the Official Representatives and Permanent Alternates

All members of the Executive Committee must appoint permanent representatives to attend regular and special meetings in their absence. This will ensure that the network's plans and programs are properly implemented and executed. The permanent representative shall have voting authority on behalf of the committee members. The ExeCom members listed their permanent representatives for the finalization and creation of formal appointments for each representative. Moreover it was recommended that the secretariat shall draft a special order to be reviewed and approved by the Local Chief Executives that includes the list of official representatives and permanent alternates.

5. Other Matters

- 5.1 The body agreed to conduct a special meeting, to discuss the juridical rights of the two municipalities on their respective boundaries, particularly to address the agreement during hot pursuit. The meeting was tentatively scheduled on December 7, 2023, in Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro. MENRO Garingalo suggested that the first joint monitoring and patrolling shall be the base-marking, and cross visit as well as joint activity of MPAN Law Enforcement Unit.
- 5.2 Deputation of personnel was also recommended and it was suggested to be signed and deputized by the two Local Chief Executive of Calintaan and Sablayan.
- 5.4 MENRO Garingalo suggested for the creation of the Sa-Ca MPAN jacket that resulted for the recommendation for the creation of the Sa-Ca MPAN logo design.

6. Closing and Adjournment

Hon. Reynaldo P. Dormido delivered the closing remarks, expressing gratitude on behalf of Mayor Dante Esteban and emphasizing the importance of the activity and the full support of LGU Calintaan in the protection, management, and conservation of our Marine Protected Areas and marine ecosystem. With nothing to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 2:50 p.m. on the motion of Ms. Luzviminda P. Alto, MPDC, LGU Sablayan, and seconded by the body.


