Class I^C caves are those with extremely hazardous conditions (e.g. bad air, unstable ceiling, presence of rockfall/breakdown, etc.) wherein the allowable activities are limited only to mapping, photography, educational and scientific purposes and closed for ecotourism activities.

ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROTECTION AND CONSERVATION PLANS FOR GIOB AND SADUG CAVES

Ilin Island, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro

I. Presentation to the Provincial Cave Committee (PCC) and approval of Resolutions Adopting the 7-Year Management, Protection and Conservation Plans for Giob and Sadug Caves to the National Cave Committee thru the Regional Office on September 12, 2023.

A meeting was called by the PCC on September 12, 2023 in Mamburao, Occidental Mindoro to let the concerned CENRO-Cave Assessment Team present the assessed caves with recommended classification within their area of responsibility.

Salient features and activities identified by the cave stakeholders stipulated in the management plans of Giob and Sadug Caves were also presented. After which, each cave management plan was moved to be approved and adopted by the PCC. (See attach advance copies of PCC Resolution Nos. 2023-002 and 2023-003)

II. Seedling production and wildlings collection for the rehabilitation activities within the 50-meter radius of the caves' buffer zones.

The CDS-Biodiversity Management Unit have collaborated with the e-NGP as the latter has established a Forest Nursery in Brgy. Batasan, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro. Forest tree species such as Narra, Philippine cedar, Bangkal, Bogo, Gmelina, Kamagong and fruit-bearing species namely jackfruit, cashew, star apple, tamarind, pomelo, avocado, Damson plum are being raised in the said nursery. Other nursery-related activities are also continuously being undertaken in the facility.

III. Fabrication and installation of information boards and signages.

As part of the IEC campaign/CEPA activities stipulated in the management plans, fabrication of 20 directional signages and 5 information boards are already ongoing to be installed in the following:





WHEREAS, on April 8, 2001 Republic Act No. 9072, otherwise known as the "National Caves and Cave Resources Management and Protection Act" was approved to carry out the national policy of conserving, protecting and managing the caves and caves resources as part of the country's natural wealth;

WHEREAS, Section 4, the DENR shall be the lead agency tasked to implement the provisions of this Act in coordination with the Department of Tourism (DOT), the National Museum, the National Historical Institute and concerned local government units (LGUs) for specific caves, except that in the Province of Palawan, the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development shall be the lead implementing agency pursuant to Republic Act No. 7611 or the Strategic Environmental Plan for Palawan Act;

WHEREAS, on July 07, 2003, the DENR Administrative Order (DAO) No. 2003-29 - "Implementing the Rules and Regulations of the National Caves and Cave Resources Management and Protection Act or RA No. 9072" was enacted to provide specific outlined mechanisms for the policy's objectives and/or purpose;

WHEREAS, on November 08, 2021, the DAO No. 2021-34 - "Guidelines for the Establishment and Implementation of the Cave Management, Protection, and Conservation Program (CMPCP)" as stated in Section 8, THAT "the DENR Regional Director may create a Provincial Cave Committee (PCC) for island provinces as appropriate. It shall be chaired by the DENR PENRO with members coming from different local agencies, academe, and non-government organizations. The PCC shall assume the duties and responsibilities of the RCC. Decisions of the PCC shall be affirmed by the Regional Director";

PRESIDENT, Colegio De San Sebastian Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro WHEREAS, on February 27, 2007, the DENR issued Memorandum Circular No. 2007-04 (Prescribing and Adopting Manual on Cave Classification) entailed THAT, upon going through the classification process, all caves within public domain and provide lands - including those found within the protected areas shall have the following classes within the Province of Occidental Mindoro:

Class I. Caves with delicate and fragile geological formations, threatened species, archaeological and paleontological values, and extremely hazardous conditions. Allowable use may include mapping, photography, educational and scientific purposes;

Class II. Caves with areas or portions which have sections that have hazardous conditions and contain sensitive geological, archaeological, cultural, historical and biological values or high-quality ecosystems. It may be necessary to close sections of these caves seasonally or permanently. It shall be opened to experienced cavers or guided educational tours/visits:

Class III. Caves that are generally safe to inexperienced visitors with no known threatened species and archaeological, geological, natural history, cultural and historical values. The caves may also be utilized for economic purposes such as guano extraction and edible birds' nest collection;

WHEREAS, from year 2015 to 2022, the DENR MIMAROPA Region PENRO/CENRO Cave Assessment Team, assistance of embedded personnel from the Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB), and support from officers of local government units (LGUs), academe and other non-government organizations (NGOs) conducted caves identification, assessment, survey and mapping in the province;

WHEREAS, the primary objective for the classification of caves is to conserve, protect and manage the natural wealth and heritage of caves and the resources found therein;

WHEREAS, the Sadug Cave Management, Protection, and Conservation Plan, in accordance with existing guidelines, was formulated from data consolidation activities through the conduct of Cave Biological and Physiological Assessment; Key Informant Interviews; and Stakeholder Planning and Workshop, that elicit the cave's unique strengths and weaknesses, as well as, outlying opportunities and threats that served as the foundation for the preparation of Management, Conservation, and Protection Plan;

WHEREAS, the Management, Conservation, and Protection Plan was formulated by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) - Community Environment and Natural Resources Office (CENRO) in San Jose, Occidental Mindoro, and aims "to provide the primary stakeholders with a general template for the management, protection, and conservation of the cave and all cave resources found therein", serves as their guide and reference regarding the activities that need to be undertaken; shall be the basis of stakeholders in implementing programs, projects, and activities for the continuous management, protection, and conservation of Sadug Cave;

WHEREAS, the Body recognizes the need for the approval and adoption of the presented management, protection, and conservation plan of the Sadug Cave and to further ensure the involvement and active participation of the national and local government, partner agencies, concerned stakeholders and the public in adopting strategies towards sustainable utilization of the cave and its natural resources;

WHEREAS, Republic Act 9072 otherwise known as the "National Caves and Cave Resources Management and Protect Act of 2001," provides that it is the policy of the State to conserve, protect and manage caves and cave resources as part of the country's natural wealth,

WHEREAS, the Giob Cave Management, Protection, and Conservation Plan, in accordance with existing guidelines, was formulated from data consolidation activities through the conduct of Cave Biological and Physiological Assessment; Key Informant Interviews; and Stakeholder Planning and Workshop, that elicit the cave's unique strengths and weaknesses, as well as, outlying opportunities and threats that served as the foundation for the preparation of Management, Conservation, and Protection Plan;

WHEREAS, the Management, Conservation, and Protection Plan was formulated by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) - Community Environment and Natural Resources Office (CENRO) in San Jose, Occidental Mindoro, and aims "to provide the primary stakeholders with a general template for the management, protection, and conservation of the cave and all cave resources found therein"; serves as their guide and reference regarding the activities that need to be undertaken; shall be the basis of stakeholders in implementing programs, projects, and activities for the continuous management, protection, and conservation of Giob Cave;

WHEREAS, the Body recognizes the need for the approval and adoption of the presented management, protection, and conservation plan of the Giob Cave and to further ensure the involvement and active participation of the national and local government, partner agencies, concerned stakeholders, and the public in adopting strategies towards sustainable utilization of the cave and its natural resources;

WHEREAS, consistent with such mandate, with the convergence of the Department, through CENRO San Jose, Municipal Local Government Unit (LGU) of San Jose, and Barangay LGU of Ansiray, Ilin Island, San Jose, Occidental formulated the Seven-Year Giob Cave Management, Protection, and Conservation Plan and presented
