Respectfully submitted is a copy of the Memorandum dated October 13, 2023 of the OIC, PENR Officer of Marinduque relative to the above subject. This is in compliance with the CY 2023 target activity under the OO1: Natural Resources Conservation and Development Program: Protected Area Management and Development Sub-program: II. For Proclaimed and Legislated PAs: 5. PAMB Operationalization in Marinduque Wildlife Sanctuary (MWS).

The 4th PAMB En Banc meeting of MWS for CY 2023 was conducted on October 3, 2023 at PENRO Conference Hall, Capitol Compound, Bangbangalon, Boac, Marinduque. The meeting was presided over by Ms. Elizabeth E. Manggol from Marinduque Council for Environmental Concern (MACEC). It was attended by twenty-eight (28) out of thirty-seven (37) PAMB members. The meeting was also attended by the representatives of the Regional Office (via Zoom), DPWH, PENRO Marinduque and MWS PAMO Staff.

In an acceptance speech, MWS-PAMB attendees were acknowledged by OIC-PENR Officer Imelda M. Diaz. The OIC-PENRO informed the body that due to the cancellation of boat trips to Marinduque, Regional Executive Director Felix S. Mirasol, Jr. would not be able to attend in person. Instead, the RED will participate in the meeting virtually via Zoom.

During the Board's plenary meeting, three (3) motions were reviewed and subsequently adopted through resolutions. The agenda that were discussed and its highlights, along with the resolutions that were adopted, are listed below:

1. PAMO Accomplishment for Third Quarter of CY 2023	
a. Monitoring of Socio-Economic Assessment and Monitoring System (SEAMS)	PASu Emeterio M. Recto reported that the PAMO has a target of 551 tenured migrants for the updating/monitoring of tenured migrants. He also reported that as of September, 2023, a total of 489 tenured migrants were interviewed together with the assessment of their homelots and farmlots. As part of data collection, an interview and geotagging of respective farm lots were done.
b. Biodiversity Assessment and Monitoring System (BAMS)	The two (2) hectares PBMA established in Brgy. Tumagabok, Boac and Brgy.

	<p>Tambangan, Sta. Cruz is currently being monitored.</p> <p>Quadrants are also being re-established, and re-tagging of trees is being conducted.</p>
c. PAMB Meeting	A regular quarterly PAMB En Banc meeting will be held as part of the PAMB Operationalization program.
d. Capacity Building	In total, there were two (2) capacity building events in 2023: one on June 21-23 and the other on September 29-30. The activities were attended by PAMB, PAMO Staff and selected TSD and MSD Staff of PENRO Marinduque.
e. PAMO Operationalization	For this year, the contracts of one (1) Ecosystem Management Specialist 1 (EMS-1) and three (3) Park Rangers were renewed.
f. Ecotourism Development Program	The PASu reported that six (6) infrastructures are being maintained. These are the PAMO building, Ecotourism Information Center, Multi-purpose Hall, Viewing Decks, Ranger Stations, and Satellite Office.
g. Management of Integrated Protected Area Fund (IPAF)	PASu Recto reported that the total amount of fees collected as of September 30, 2023, is Php 23,985.00.
h. Inventory of Tenurial Instrument	<p>PASu Recto reported that majority of the tenurial instrument issued within the MWS are Integrated Social Forestry (ISF) located in Brgy. Ilaya and Brgy. Tumagabok, Boac.</p> <p>Additionally, there are three (3) Community-Based Forest Management (CBFM) areas which will be converted to PACBRMA once the Agreement expires.</p>
i. Maintenance of Signages and Demarcated Corners	The Park Rangers and PAMO's Biodiversity Protection Assistants (BPAs) conducted regular patrolling, monitoring, and maintenance activities.
j. Lawin Forest and Biodiversity Protection System	The PAMO has a regular target of 240 kilometers every year. The PAMO was able to patrol 30.28 kilometers for the month of July, 21.64 kilometers for the month of August, and 22.38 kilometers for the month of September.

Boi and Bayuti up to the rice field with a length of 700 meters can be converted from Strict Protection Zone to Multiple Use Zone. No more opening of additional farm lots in addition to the existing. The existing open area must be considered as an area for rehabilitation instead of seedling replacement to be undertaken by the DPWH contractor for

a. Monuments monitored and maintained	Four Hundred Eight (408) monuments will be monitored and maintained with a proposed budget of Php 408,000.00.
b. Signages monitored and maintained	Two Hundred Eighty-Three (283) installed signages will be monitored and maintained with a proposed budget of Php 300,000.00.
c. Capacity Building	Training/Learning events will be conducted with a proposed budget of Php 630,000.00.
d. PAMB Meeting	Four (4) PAMB meetings and eight (8) resolutions will be targetted for CY 2024 with a proposed budget of Php 360,000.00.
e. PAMO Operationalization	Nine (9) contract personnel will be hired for CY 2024. These include: one (1) EMS I; six (6) Park Rangers; and two (2) Tourism Coordinators with a proposed budget of Php 1,698,000.00.

RED Mirasol advised the body that funding for the undertaking needs to be requested to

	the Central Office through a PAMB resolution requesting the BMB via the DENR-MIMAROPA Region for the allotment of funds to carry out the updating of the Management Zoning and updating of the MWS PAMP.
b. Livelihood program for Tenured Migrants	Keg. Johnny C. Francisco proposed that planning and budgeting for livelihood programs for TM should be included.
c. Other BMS sites	Dr. Mascareñas requested that the BMS sites established in Brgy. Makulapnit, Sta. Cruz and Bagtingon, Buenavista should also be considered.

For Proclaimed and Legislated PAs: 5. PAMB Operationalization: C. Management Effectiveness Assessment with indicator: No. of Management Effectiveness Assessment (MEA) conducted following BMB TB No. 2018-05 for Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary (RIWS) in Narra, Palawan.

The MEA was conducted on October 5, 2023 at the PENRO Training Hall, Puerto Princesa, Palawan with nine (9) out of seventeen (17) respondents from RIWS-Protected Area Management Board (RIWS-PAMB) members. The total number of respondents is in compliance with Section 4 of BMB TB 2018-05, requiring 50% + 1 members of the PAMB.

The following are the summary results of the MEA using METT as conducted by the RIWS Protected Area Management Office (RIWS-PAMO):

1. On Threats:

- a. The following are the threats identified and categorized as low (threats that are present but not seriously impacting values) based on BMB TB 2018-05:
1. Tourism and recreation infrastructure;
 2. Annual and perennial non-timber crop cultivation;
 3. Biological resource use and harm within a protected area;
 4. Human intrusions and disturbance within a protected area;
 5. Pollution entering or generated within protected area (garbage and solid waste);
 6. Erosion and siltation/ deposition (e.g. due to fire or riverbed changes);
 7. Climate change and severe weather (droughts, storms and flooding); and
 8. Specific cultural and social threats.

2. On Management Effectiveness:

- a. *Context* – status of the important aspects of the protected area, threats, and policy environment: METT rating of 66.67%
- b. *Planning* – appropriateness of protected area design and planning: METT rating of 82.72%
- c. *Inputs* – adequacy of resources needed to carry out management: METT rating of 65.74%

- d. *Processes* – efficiency and appropriateness of management conducted: METT rating of 78.45%
 - e. *Outputs/Outcomes* – effectiveness and appropriateness of management in relation to objectives: METT rating of 60.49%
3. The overall METT rating for CY 2023 (77.01%) as computed by the RIWS-PAMO was re-computed by the DENR MIMAROPA Regional Office and found to be inaccurate due to some errors and mismatches between the formula and computation sheet (in Excel file). After recomputation, the METT rating for CY 2023 was corrected to **71.11%** which is equivalent to **Good** management effectiveness.



Province	Summary of IEC Activity
PENRO Oriental Mindoro CENRO Socorro	<p>On August 24, 2023, the CENRO Socorro Monitoring and Enforcement Section (MES) personnel conducted an IEC lecture, which was attended by the barangay officials, sitio leaders, and selected forest occupants. A total of 48 participants (27 female and 19 male) attended the said activity in Barangay Batong Dalig, Socorro, Oriental Mindoro. The objective of the said IEC activity was to educate the participants and spread awareness of various ENR laws.</p> <p>On September 27, 2023, the team also conducted an IEC campaign attended by a total of 18 participants (12 male and 6 female) from the barangay councils, the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), and affected communities in Barangay Montemayor, Naujan, Oriental Mindoro. The objective of the said IEC activity was to inform the participants of the policies and requirements for tree cutting for various DPWH projects.</p> <p>An open forum concluded the events, wherein common issues were raised by the participants and addressed by CENRO Socorro personnel.</p>
PENRO Romblon	<p>On August 11, 2023, the PENRO Romblon MES personnel conducted Community Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) at the San Agustin Commercial Complex in San Agustin, Romblon. It was attended by personnel from the Municipal Agriculture Office (MAO), Municipal Disaster Risk and Reduction Management Office (MDRRMO), Municipal</p>

	<p>Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO), Municipal Planning and Development Office (MPDO), the Municipal Administrator, barangay officials and staff of the fifteen (15) barangays of the Municipality of San Agustin, elements of the San Agustin Municipal Police Station and Coast Guard sub-station. After the forum, a post-program evaluation and distribution of certificates were conducted.</p> <p>The goal of the said activity was to impart knowledge on ENR laws, rules, and regulations and to encourage the participants to be co-partners in the protection and conservation of our environment and natural resources.</p>
PENRO Palawan CENRO Taytay	<p>On August 1, 2023, the CENRO Taytay MES personnel conducted Community Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) in Barangays New Ibajay and Mabini, El Nido, Palawan. A total of fifty-five (55) participants (26 males and 29 females) attended the activity composed of barangay officials and their constituents. The objective of the event was to strengthen collaboration with local government units and environmentalists in the locality.</p> <p>An open forum was conducted in which various issues and concerns were raised by the participants and were addressed accordingly by the CENRO Taytay personnel. IEC materials were also distributed.</p>

There were 31,816 seedlings replanted out of the targeted 41,024 seedlings and with 189 families who participated in the said activity.


On the other hand, the third (3rd) year maintenance and protection maintained 100% of 4,663.64 hectares of NGP plantation. There were also 123,236 seedlings out of targeted 592,442 seedlings to be replanted, and with 1,311 families who participated in maintaining the area.

In addition, the following activities were undertaken such as ring weeding, strip brushing, foot patrol and fireline establishment to maintain and protect the planted seedlings.

As regards, the financial status of the project, the second (2nd) year maintenance and protection (M&P), the PENROs already obligated one hundred (100%) percent of the allotted funds and disbursed 48.47% percent of fund allocation. Meanwhile on the third year maintenance and protection (M&P), the PENROs also obligated the one hundred percent (100%) of the allocated funds and disbursed the 55.67% of the allocations.

There were three forest fire incidents that occurred within the established Enhanced National Greening Program (eNGP) plantation in Brgy. Malibago, Torrijos, Marinduque in year 2020, 2021, and 2023. The incidents were allegedly done by farmers and livestock owners entering the plantations, and damaged a total of 11.9 hectares of the NGP sites. The cost of damages amounted to P312,969.361 were computed, based on the seedling production up to establishment including year 1 and year 2 maintenance and protection per hectare. Further, the damaged areas were already rehabilitated by the NGP contractors with the guidance of NGP Field Personnel.

Enclosed herewith are the detailed reports, map of area burned and geotagged photos submitted by PENRO Marinduque.
