SUBJECT : **COMPLIANCE MONITORING OF EXISTING WILDLIFE FARMS (WFP/WCP) AND CERTIFICATE OF WILDLIFE REGISTRATION (CWR) FOR THE FOURTH (4<sup>TH</sup>) QUARTER IN THE PROVINCE OF MARINDUQUE**

Respectfully submitted is the Compliance Monitoring of existing Wildlife Farms (WFP/WCP) and Certificate of Wildlife Registration (CWR) for the Fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) Quarter in the Province of Marinduque.

**FINDINGS AND OBSERVATIONS:**

**1. Wildlife Farm Permit (WFP)/Wildlife Collector’s Permit (WCP)**

It was observed that the Thirteen (13) WFP and WCP holders updated their sign board which was displayed in the entrance of their facility. Furthermore, they also reminded to observe proper labeling of scientific names of the butterflies and their host plants.

Be informed that as of this date, there are Sixty-five (65) Local Transport Permit issued to the Twelve (12) WFP/WCP holders. (Please see table below).

The WFP/WCP holders released the ten percent (10%) of total production of captive bred endemic species in Brgy. Ihatub, Boac, Marinduque dated October 26, 2023 in order to replenish the wild population of the endemic species in the Province of Marinduque.

During the ocular inspection with the Monitoring Team from Enforcement Division of DENR MIMAROPA Region, it was found out that the registered farm of Mr. Marion Abundo, an owner of Tropical Insects Enterprises is disestablished and was relocated in the property of Mr. Oscar Mendeja with a cadastral Lot No. 1409pt. Cad 544-D through Contract of Lease dated September 25, 2023. However, there is no formal request for the transfer of location of his farm in this Office.

The Monitoring Team with DENR PENRO Marinduque personnel had a conversation with the spouse of Mr. Oscar Mendeja namely Mrs. Sixta Mendeja. They asked if there is a copy of Contract of Lease between his spouse and Mr. Abundo. She shown a copy of their Contract of Lease covering the month of September 2023 to December 31, 2029.

## 2. Certificate of Wildlife Registration (CWR)

Mr. Eric Oria, the Certificate of Wildlife Registration holder complied with the submission of inventory report and proper labeling of wildlife species for identification. The monitoring Team from Enforcement Division with DENR PENRO Marinduque personnel filled out the prescribed Inventory/Monitoring Report forms. They were also informed by the holder with regards to the rapid growth of the Red Iguana (a morph of Green Iguana) which was inspected by the Regional Monitoring Team on August 17, 2023.

## RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Mr. Marion Abundo is hereby recommended to informed the Office through formal request to state the situation with supporting documents to properly address the circumstances and endorsed it for consideration to the Regional Office.
2. Sustain their compliance and maintenance of cleanliness and sanitation of the butterfly farm and facility to prevent possible contamination and /or spread pests and diseases which may affect the survival of wildlife species in the area.

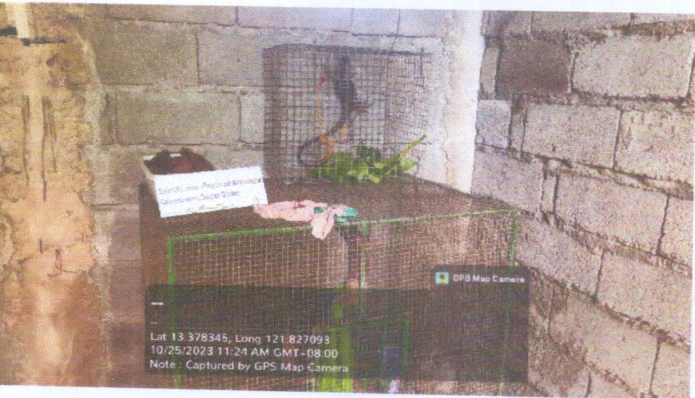
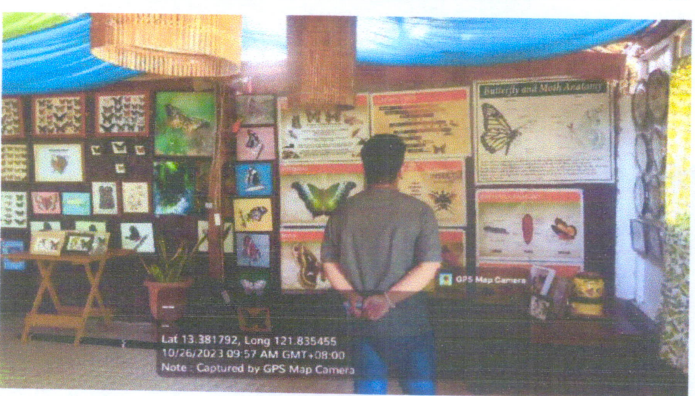
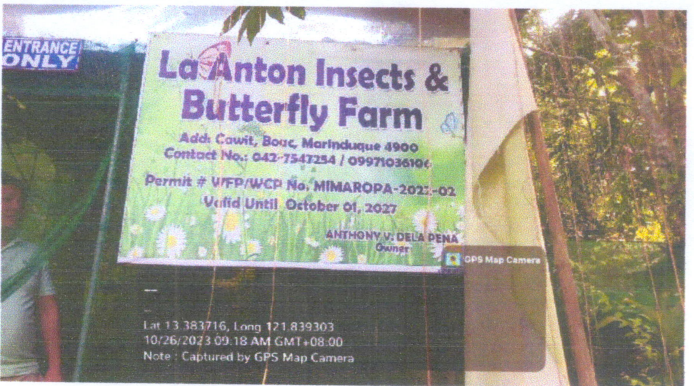
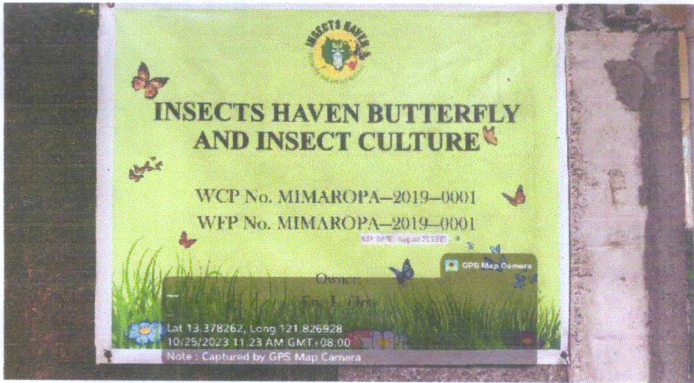
