Please be informed that personnel of Monitoring and Enforcement Section are continuously conducting monitoring of five (5) ports within Barangay Buyabod, Sta. Cruz, Barangay Balanacan, Mogpog, Brgy. Dos, Gasan, Brgy. Cawit, Boac and Airport in Barangay Masiga, Gasan. Marinduque Airport within Barangay Masiga, Gasan Marinduque was temporarily closed for domestic flights but open for private activities such as pilot training activity.

Likewise, the Team also coordinated with other Government Agencies (OGAs) particularly the Philippine National Police, PNP-Maritime, Philippine Port Authority (PPA), Philippine Coast Guard and LGUs of Barangay and requested for the collaborative effort to monitor the possible movement of undocumented wildlife and forest products within and outside of the province of Marinduque. There were no illegal transport of wildlife and forest products detected by the Team during the month of November 2023.

In compliance with the target on Operation Against Illegal Environmental and Natural Resources, specifically on Mobilization of Wildlife Traffic Monitoring Unit (WTMU) in air, and sea ports, the team of PENRO Marinduque conducted the following activities, to wit:

- (a) That on November 9, 2023, the team of Wildlife Traffic Monitoring Unit (WTMU) coordinated with Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) P02 Denmark O. Cueto Outsource Personnel relative to the manning in Brgy. Dos Port Gasan, Marinduque;
- (b) That we discussed with the PCG the activities and functions of our team;
- (c) That only small passenger boat travels from Marinduque to Pinamalayan Oriental Mindoro and vice-versa;
- (d) That in Marinduque Airport located in Barangay Masiga, Gasan, there is still no domestic flight in said airport; and
- (e) That in the Port of Cawit, there is still no schedule of trips of passenger vessel. Only cargo vessel and barge are berthed in the port to unload cements and local rice (NFA).

During the monitoring, there are no encountered illegal wildlife trade and transport of forest products/minerals during the said period.

It is recommended to continuously conduct Information, Education and Communication Campaign through dissemination of information materials such as flyers regarding Republic Act No. 9147 and other DENR forestry laws, Rules and regulation.
