This pertains to the request of Oceancell Trading International Corporation represented by Mr. Edwin G. Bernardino for issuance of permit to cut naturally grown trees that will be affected by the proposed development of the area within a private land covered by Transfer Certificate of Title (TCT) No. 074-2014000537 located in Barangay San Pedro, Puerto Princesa City.

Considering the merit of the request, PENRO/CENRO recommendations, compliance to documentary requirements of the applicant, and pursuant to the DENR Administrative Order No. 2022-10 re: “Revised DENR Manual of Authorities on Technical Matters”, **PRIVATE LAND TIMBER PERMIT NO. DENR MIMAROPA REGION-2023-071** *ff* is hereby granted in favor of Oceancell Trading International Corporation represented by Mr. Edwin G. Bernardino to cut two (2) naturally grown trees of various species within the above-cited titled property having a net harvestable volume of 0.51 cu.m. after deducting the 30% allowance for internal defects and harvesting inefficiency as shown in the table below:

Attached permit shall only be released upon replacement of the permittee of **two hundred (200) seedlings, strictly of indigenous species with at least one (1) meter in height to the DENR Field Office concerned**, pursuant to Memorandum Order No. 2012-02 dated 05 November 2012 known as “Uniform Replacement Ratio for Cut or Relocated Trees”, in support to the National Greening Program (NGP) and Climate Change initiatives of the Government, preferably Pagatpat and Api-api mangrove species.

Submit monitoring report with geo-tagged photographs in effect of this Memorandum for reference and record purposes.

Pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 705, as amended, DENR Administrative Order No. 2022-10 dated May 30, 2022, regarding the “*Revised DENR Manual of Authorities on Technical Matters*”, and to the existing Forestry laws, rules, and regulations, is hereby granted to:

OCEANCELL TRADING INTERNATIONAL CORPORATION
REPRESENTED BY MR. EDWIN G. BERNARDINO

Corporation/Citizen of the Republic of the Philippines with official address at 478 San Fernando, Brgy. 282, San Nicolas, Binondo, Manila, to cut **two (2) naturally grown trees of various species** with a net harvestable volume of **0.51 cu.m.**

This PERMIT is subject to pertinent Forestry laws, rules, and regulations and on the following terms and conditions, to wit:

1. Two (2) naturally grown trees within a private land covered by Transfer Certificate of Title (TCT) No. 074-2014000537 located in Barangay San Pedro, Puerto Princesa City, having a net harvestable volume of **0.51 cubic meters** after deducting the 30% allowance for internal defects and harvesting shall be authorized to be cut, as shown in the Table below:

Rain tree (Acacia)	1	0.37
Anabiong (Anagdong)	1	0.14
TOTAL	2	0.51

2. Prior to tree cutting operation, placards, or signboards with dimensions of 4 feet by 8 feet should be installed at conspicuous places to inform the public that the tree cutting operation is authorized by the DENR. Such notice of particulars should indicate the name of the permittee, the purpose of the activities to be undertaken, and the number of trees to be cut;
3. The tree cutting operation shall at all times be under the direct supervision of the PENRO concerned or duly authorized representatives. The PENRO shall be administratively, civilly, and criminally liable, should this Permit be used for any illegal purpose;
4. The trees cut and parts thereof shall belong to the permittee subject to payment of forest charges. Provided, that in case of transport, necessary transport documents shall be secured from the Local DENR Field Office concerned;
5. The permittee shall replace each tree cut with one hundred (100) seedlings or a total of two hundred (200) seedlings, strictly of indigenous species with at least one (1) meter in height to the DENR Field Office concerned, in compliance with the DENR Memorandum Order (DMO) No. 2012-02 dated November 5, 2012, re: “*Uniform Replacement for Cut and Relocated Trees*” to be turned over to the local DENR Field Office concerned in support to the National Greening Program (NGP) and climate change initiatives of the Government, preferably Pagatpat and Api-api mangrove species;

6. The *chainsaw* that will be used in the felling/cutting operations shall be registered to the DENR pursuant to Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9175 and its implementing rules and regulations under DENR Administrative Order (DAO) 2003-24 dated June 20, 2003;
7. The permittee shall be required to undertake measures during and after cutting operation to mitigate the negative impacts of the said activity on the locality; and
8. Violation of any of the above conditions shall be sufficient ground for termination/cancellation of the permit, subject to due process without prejudice to the imposition of appropriate penalties pursuant to existing regulations.

This PERMIT is effective on the date of issuance and expires **fifty (50) days** upon the receipt of the Permittee or as soon as the volume authorized herein is exhausted, whichever comes first.
