Respectfully submitted is the Memorandum dated September 13, 2023 of OIC, PENRO Occidental Mindoro regarding the abovementioned subject.

Based on the report submitted, the following activities were conducted:

1. Capacity Building on Basic Caving and Cave Guiding for Pumaga/Taboy-Taboy Cave on July 18-19, 2023 held at Brgy. Purnaga, Magsaysay, Occidental Mindoro

Thirty-five (35) individuals, consisting of 12 females and 23 males attended the capacity building. The participants included representatives from LGU-Magsaysay (MENRO, Tourism and MDRRMO), Barangay LGU of Purnaga, selected members of the HAGURA tribes, PENRO-CDS Chief and staff, Occidental Mindoro State College (OMSC), National Commission on Indigenous People (NCIP), and selected DENR-CENRO Cave Assessment Team members.

2. Seedling production for the reforestation/rehabilitation activities on the identified areas within the cave sites

This activity is being conducted at the Forest Nursery in Barangay Batasan, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro in collaboration with the eNGP Unit of CENRO San Jose. The facility raises a wide variety of fruit-bearing species, including Jackfruit, Cashew, Santol, Tamarind, Kalumpit, and Star apple, as well as forest tree species, including Narra, Dao, Malugay, Ipil, Banaba, Bangkal, Nato, Malabahay, Fire tree, and Bamboo.

3. Preparation of information boards and directional signages





Respectfully submitted is the Memorandum dated September 22, 2023 of OIC PENRO Romblon regarding the above subject in compliance with the target under OOI: Natural Resources Conservation and Development Program: Protected Areas, Caves and Wetlands Development and Management Sub-program: I. Proclaimed and Legislated PAs: 4. PA Habitat Protection; A. Implementation of Biodiversity Monitoring System (BMS) within Mt. Guiting – Guiting Natural Park (MGGNP) in Sibuyan, Romblon.

BMS was conducted using four (4) main methods: Focus Group Discussion (FGD), Field Diary, Photo Documentation and Transect Walk.

**1. Focus Group Discussion (FGD)**

FGD was conducted on August 05-06, 2023 within the municipalities of San Fernando and Cajidiocan. The members of the Community Monitoring Group (CMG) from Barangays Panangcalan and Agtiwa in San Fernando and Barangay Lumbang Weste in Cajidiocan actively participated in providing information on the trends of biodiversity and resource uses within the protected area.

## 2. FIELD DIARY

Field Diary and patrolling activities showed that illegal forest activity within the protected area is still observed. This is due to insufficient number of patrollers who conduct regular patrolling and surveillance in the immense forestland of the protected area. Appropriate legal actions are being undertaken against the violators. Recommended PAMB actions include 1) creation of composite team composed of DENR, PNP, PCG and Philippine Army to support in intelligence, surveillance and apprehension of involved persons in illegal cutting of trees and to combat illegal gold mining and other illegal forest activities; 2) deployment of additional Forest/Park Rangers to man the island forest cover; 3) encourage LGUs/BLGUs to share their responsibilities in protection and conservation of natural resources within their jurisdiction; and 4.) intensify CEPA activities in the problem areas.

## 3. PHOTO DOCUMENTATION

For this semester, a series of photo documentation was undertaken on the six (6) established sites: 1) So. Mangibyong, Brgy. Mabulo, San Fernando, 2) So. Dalit Lumbang Weste, Cajidiocan, 3) Mapayapa/Haguimit Site, Cajidiocan, 4) So. Libo-o, Brgy. Taclobo, San Fernando, 5) Brgy.

Cantagda/Silum, Magdiwang and 6) So. Sinapawan, Brgy. Lumbang, Weste San Fernando, Romblon. There were no significant changes observed in the area.

#### 4. TRANSECT WALK

The table below shows the priority species observed in five (5) established transect route sites: 1) So. Binalabag, Brgy. Tampayan, Magdiwang; 2) Brgy. Cantagda, Magdiwang; 3) So. Haguimit, Brgy. Lumbang Weste, Cajidiocan; 4) So. Cross Country, Brgy. España, San Fernando and 5) Brgy. Mabulo, San Fernando Romblon.

Respectfully referred is the Memorandum dated 06 November 2023 of OIC, PENRO Occidental Mindoro forwarding the Completed Staff Work (CSW) dated 20 February 2023 of the Technical Working Group (TWG) of PENRO Occidental Mindoro recommending the Forest Land Grazing Management Agreement (FLGMA) No. 12 to be developed into an economic zone under the Philippine Economic Zone Authority (PEZA) located in Sitios Boktot, Urilan and Udalo, Brgy. Lumangbayan, Abra de Ilog, Occidental Mindoro. The FLGMA No. 12 was awarded to the University of Perpetual Help Rizal, Inc. (UPHRI) represented by its Chairman of the Board and CEO Dr. Antonio L. Tamayo on 01 March 2006. It has an approximate area of 2,000 hectares.

Said CSW was in response to the letter dated 04 April 2022 of Dr. Anthony Jose M. Tamayo and Capt. Robert Joseph S. Moran requesting the DENR Secretary, that the aforementioned FLGMA issued to TJ Enterprises, Inc. be proclaimed as an eco-zone with the PEZA which shall engage Agro-Industrial and Agro-Forestry projects.

The aforementioned CSW disclosed the following:

1. TJ Enterprises, the FLGMA holder, is compliant with the Terms and Conditions on the management, development, conservation and protection of the approved area. However, the holder shall update their payment for the Annual Government Share (AGS), submit the Operational Plan and Grazing Management Plan; and
2. Aside from grazing, a portion of the approved area has high potential for timber production and ecotourism purposes.

The TWG strongly supports the proposed designation of the area as Economic Zone (Eco-Zone) taking into consideration the strict implementation of conservation and protection measures of the biophysical features of the said area.
