REPORTS REQUIRED OF EACH REGISTRANT

- 1. Number and date of issuance and expiration of the license or permit of his principal.
- 2. Change of address by giving his/her new address.
- 3. Quarterly report to be submitted not later than the fifth day after the end of each quarter on purchases and sales or disposal, in the case of dealers.
- 4. In case of dealer, the annual gross value of his/her business to be reported not later than the first day of March of every year.
- 5. His/Her knowledge of any violations, of the provisions of Act No. 1239 and of these regulations, giving the name and address of the violator and nature of nature of violation.

PROHIBITIONS

- 1. For log dealer:
 - (a) To purchase logs, lumber or piles cut illegally.
 - (b) To purchase or borrow logs from other sources for export.
 - (c) To conduct logging operation directly or indirectly outside its own concession.
- 2. For lumber dealer and lumber yard operator:
 - (a) To purchase logs, lumber or piles cut illegally.
 - (b) To purchase or borrow lumber from other sources for export.
 - (c) To conduct logging operation directly or indirectly outside its own concession.

"Causes for Suspension or Cancellation of Registration"

- 1. When the Certificate of registration has been produced thru fraud, misrepresentation or any false or misleading statement.
- For failure to give certain information that the Secretary of the Department Environment and Natural Resources may require from the registrant.
- 3. When a licensee's agent or contractor uses his own capital and/or equipment in the business.
- For any violation of the terms and conditions of the Certificate of Registration, the provisions of these regulations of the Forest and Internal Revenue laws and regulations.

PENAL PROVISIONS: "Any person found to be directly or indirectly responsible for the violation of Republic Act No. 1239 or of an of the provision of these regulations shall be punished by a fine of not more than ONE THOUSAND PESOS (Php 1,000.00) or imprisonment of not more than one (1) year".

ADDITIONAL RULES

The mere grant of a Certificate of Registration as Lumber Dealer shall not be construed as a privilege for expiration and shall be limited only to on buying of lumber from legitimate producer and catering same to the limited community.

The certificate is likewise subject to all rules and regulations that this Office may hereinafter prescribe.

In accordance with Section 79 of Presidential Decree No. 705, as amended, the herein permittee must issue an invoice for each sale of lumber stating the kind, standard and size sold to each purchaser is exactly the same as described therein.

Violation shall be sufficient ground for a least two (2) years suspension of the license and at least Php 200.00 fine or value of the invoice whichever is greater.
