PROCEEDINGS OF THE SECOND CLUSTER OF THE CONSULTATION WORKSHOP ON THE DRAFT REVISED GUIDELINES ON SPECIAL USE AGREEMENT IN PROTECTED AREAS AND UPDATING OF THE NATIONAL ECOTOURISM STRATEGY AND ACTION PLAN (NESAP) BACK TO BACK WITH THE VALIDATION OF THE MANAGEMENT EFFECTIVENESS TRACKING TOOL (METT) SCORES OF SELECTED

PROTECTED AREAS

We are pleased to provide you copy of the proceedings of the Second Cluster Consultation Workshop on the draft revised guidelines on Special Use Agreements in Protected Areas (SAPA) and updating of the National Ecotourism Strategy and Action Plan (NESAP) back to back with the validation of Management Effectiveness Tracking Tool (METT) scores held on 6-11 February 2023 in Cebu City, with annexes provided through: https://bit.ly/2ndConsult Visayas.

The Second Cluster covered Regions V, VI, VII, VIII and MIMAROPA and was participated in by the Chiefs of Conservation and Development Division (CDD) and their representatives, PA Superintendents, Assistant Protected Area Superintendents including representatives from the DOT, FMB, technical Divisions of the BMB, EMB and BMB-Foreign-Assisted and Special Projects such as the SIBOL and BD Corridor Projects.

The Workshop served as a venue to:

- 1. Solicit inputs, comments and recommendations on the following draft policies:
 - a. Guidelines amending the rules and regulations on SAPA;
 - b. Guidelines on the issuance of Provisional Agreement for Special Uses in Protected Areas;
 - c. Guidelines on the execution of the MOA for co-management, development, resource use, research and other activities in protected areas; and
 - d. Updating of the NESAP
- 2. Identify issues, gaps and concerns from the implementation of the existing policies relative to SAPA and NESAP and address those in the updating and revision of said policies; and
- 3. Gather innovative strategies and approaches that may be applicable to special uses in PAs and ecotourism.

The 3rd Cluster Consultation will be held this March 2023. Inputs and recommendations from the consultation workshop will be processed by the Bureau before endorsing to the DENR-Policy Technical Working Group. Hence, should you have further

- 7. Balinsasayao Twin Lakes Natural Park
- 8. Cuatro Islas Protected Landscape and Seascape
- 9. Guiuan Marine Resource Protected Landscape and Seascape
- 10. Samar Island Natural Park
- 11. Biri Larosa Protected Landscape and Seascape
