

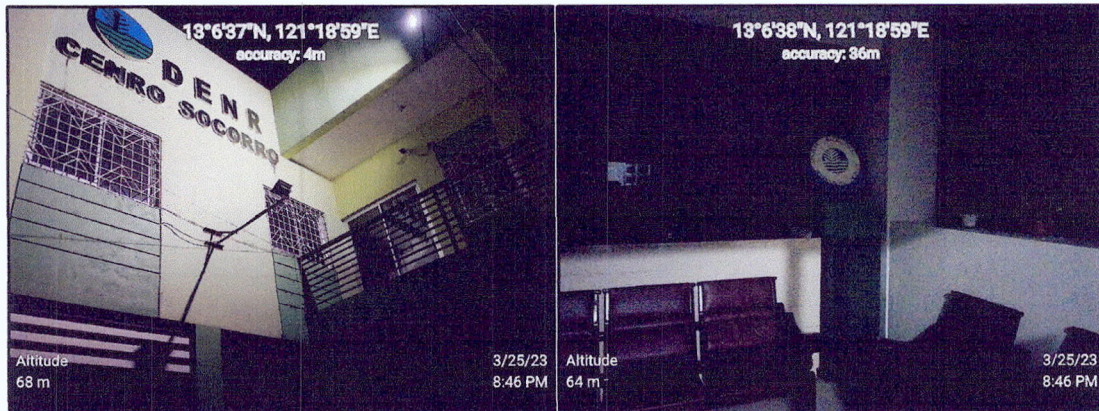


Figure 1. Participation of the CENRO Socorro, Oriental Mindoro to Earth Hour 2023.

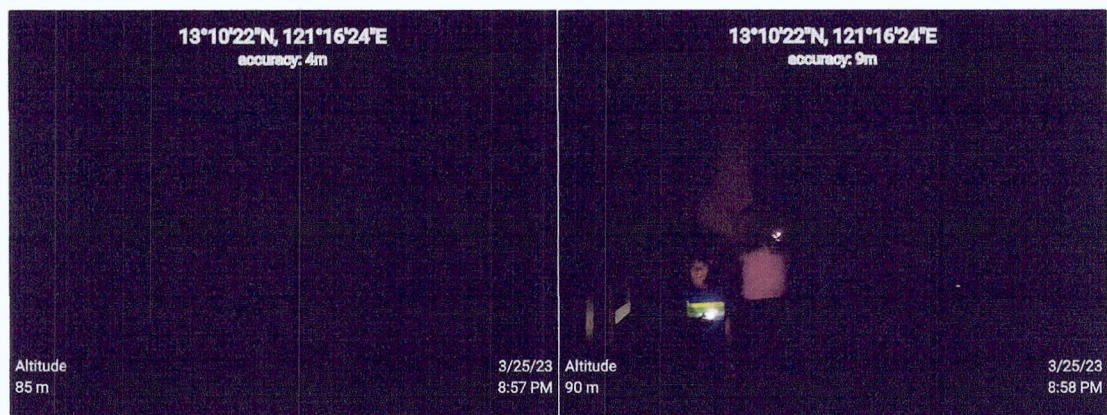


Figure 2. Participation of CENR Officer Rodel M. Boyles to Earth Hour 2023.

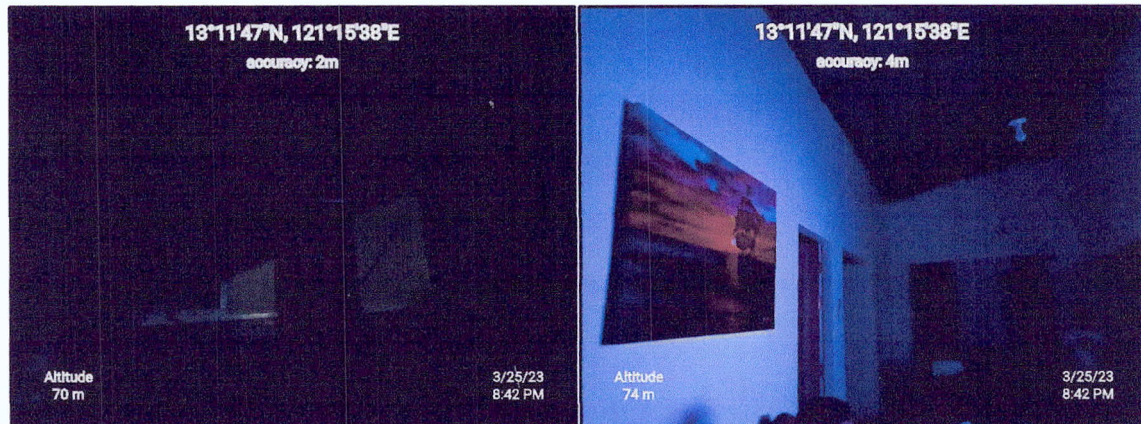


Figure 4. Participation of EcoMS II/ Chief, APMSS Rayson C. Alfante to Earth Hour 2023.

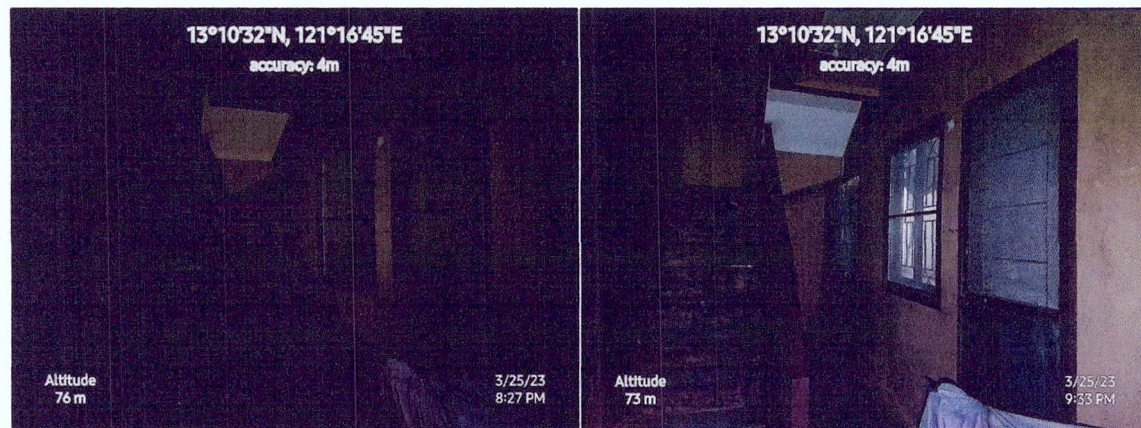


Figure 5. Participation of Forester I Mackaley P. Martinez to Earth Hour 2023.

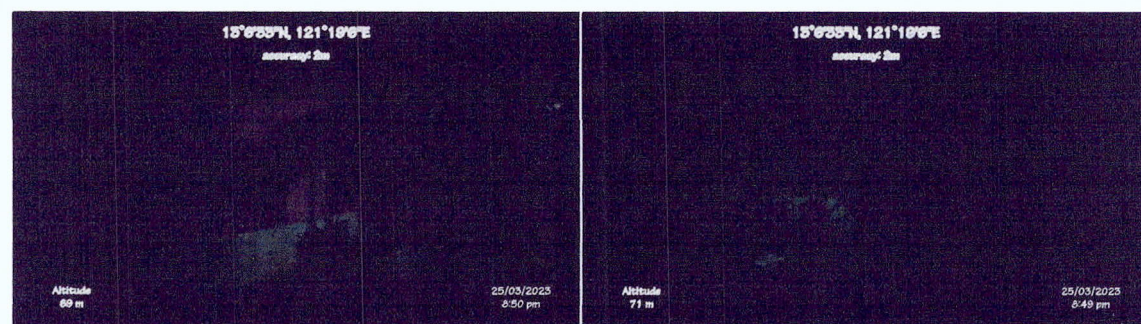


Figure 6. Participation of EcoMS I Jose Maria M. Fontanilla and FT I Adrian V. Catud to Earth Hour 2023.

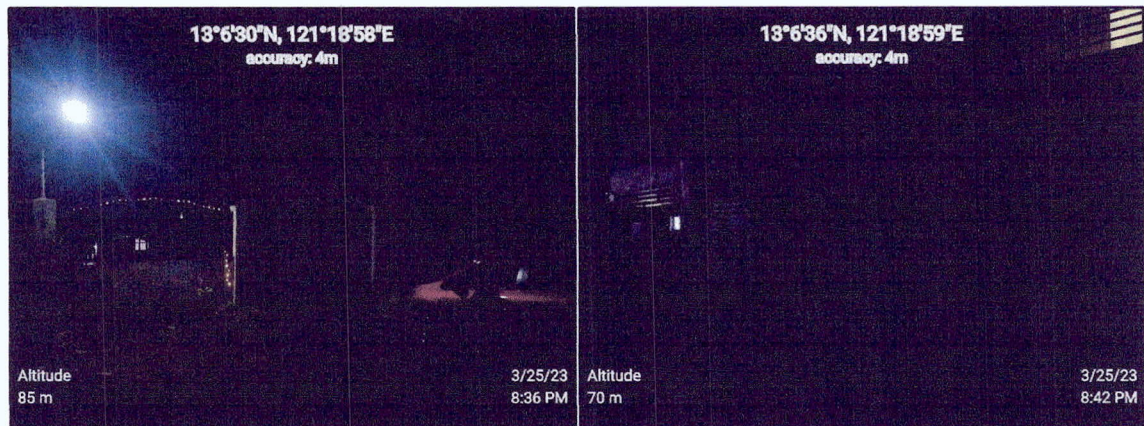


Figure 7. Participation of FT II Michael Anjelo A. Acuzar and AO I Marjorie Joyce C. Acuzar to Earth Hour 2023.

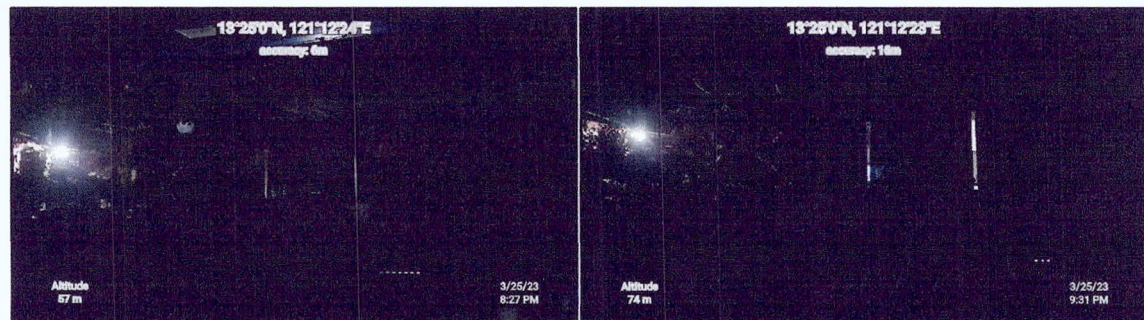


Figure 8. Participation of FT II Virginia G. Versosa to Earth Hour 2023.

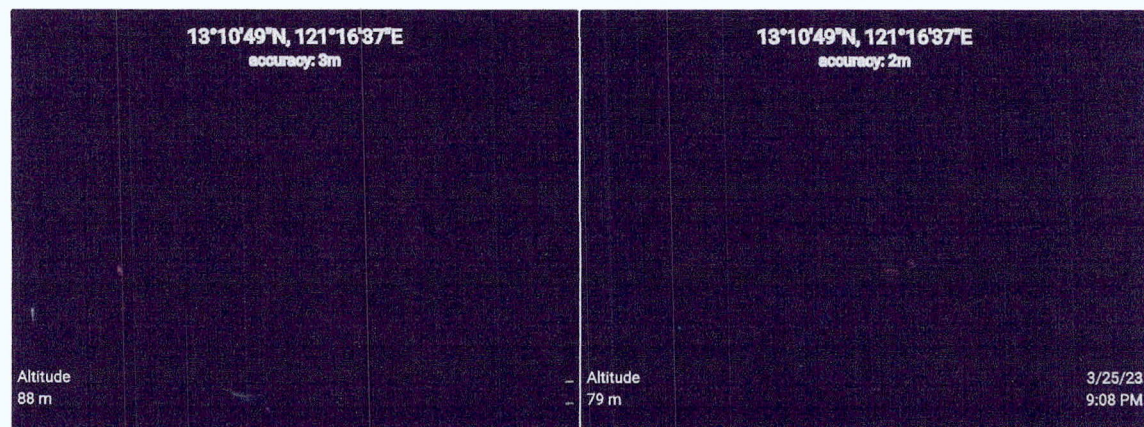


Figure 9. Participation of FT I Romalyn Fortu-Flores and FR Eric C. Gito to Earth Hour 2023.
