The Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) and Department of Agriculture (DA) issued the Joint Administrative Order (JAO) 2021-01 on Mainstreaming Biodiversity- Friendly Agricultural Practices (BDFAPs) In Protected Areas and Wider Agricultural Landscapes with primary objectives of a) promoting agricultural development that is compatible with the conservation of the ecosystems in areas where agricultural and fisheries activities are carried out; and b) conserving genetic diversity of biological resources used for food and agriculture through the institutionalization of BDFAPs.

Pursuant to Section 9 of the said JAO, the DENR and DA shall lead the conduct of the capacity building on BDFAPs. Relative to this, the DENR-Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB) and DA-Policy Research Service (PRS) and Bureau of Soils and Water Management (BSWM), in collaboration with the DENR-UNDP/GEF Biological Corridor Project, will be facilitating the nationwide capacity building on the implementation of the said JAO to the oversight committee at the national and regional level composed of representatives from DENR and DA Central Office, Bureaus, Attached Agencies and Regional and Field Offices and other concerned agencies and stakeholders. The activity aimed to capacitate the oversight committee and build awareness on the ongoing initiatives and gaps related to biodiversity and agriculture. The participants are expected to implement and cascade the said policy to respective Field Offices and/or Protected



Area Management Office in order to further mainstream BDFAP-related activities. The capacity building shall be conducted in clusters as follows:
