HIGHLIGHTS

Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) seeks to conserve the remaining forest through protection, reforestation of denuded areas, assisted natural regeneration (ANR) of remaining forest, and secure the protection and maintenance of planted trees.

The Forest Protection project also aims to achieve the following:

- (1) Compliance with the JVA requirements;
- (2) Strengthening existing collaboration(s) with the MENRO, PCSD, DENR, Municipal LGU, and Local Government Units (LGU) of Ransang and Candawaga, Rizal and other local communities and partners especially with the protection and reforestation of the denuded forest;
- (3) Supporting the National Greening Program of the Government (NGP);
- (4) Further enhancement of the awareness and capabilities of the local communities in the protection, reforestation of denuded forest and establishment of endemic fruits & trees, and high-value fruit tree plantation;
- (5) Effective mobilization of local communities towards the protection of the remaining forest and establishment of high-value fruit tree plantation; and
- (6) help improve the living condition of IP's and non-IPs through the promotion of raising the indigenous tree and fruit tree seedlings.



For January 2023, the Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) has accomplished the following activities:

- a. Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) company continued conducting Seedlings Care and Maintenance activities like watering, weeding and application of organic pesticide & foliar fertilizer. At the end of the month, the nursery caretaker conducted a seedlings inventory to sort out the seedlings is be outplanted to the ground and for care & protection of the remaining seedlings in the forest tree nursery. The total seedlings stock in forest tree nurseries is twelve thousand eight hundred seventy-five (12,875) seedlings. (Please see photos attached as ANNEX A)
- b. Last January 2023, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) the land negotiation team conducted an Information Education Campaign (IEC) in Sitio Pinagkubuan, Lower Malutok, Ransang and Sitio Tawa-tawa, Candawaga, Rizal, Palawan. The team explained to the attendees the benefits of the coconut farming program of the company, organic practices and protection of the environment. Also, the team encouraged the IP community not to sell their ancestral land to other persons because, in the next generation, there will be no ancestral lands bequeathed to their children. The activities were participated by the local community of Brgy. Ransang and Candawaga, Rizal, Palawan. (Please see photos attached as ANNEX B)
- c. Last January 2023, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) continued conducting silviculture activity such as strip brushing and also replacement of Mahogany seedlings mortality. The purpose of this activity is to control competing forest vegetation and reduce competition for space, light, moisture, and nutrients with crop tree seedlings. - d. Last January 2023, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) Foot Patrol Unit continued conducting on-site regular monitoring of illegal activities inside the approved Agroforestry Development Project and neighboring areas. Based on the report made by the Foot Patrol Unit, for January the team roamed and observed the different areas there is no



trace of Illegal activities in the vicinity and neighbors of the Lionheart areas. (*Please see photos attached as ANNEX D*)


