This has reference to the DENR FY- 2023 Physical and Financial Plan Program of Activity Menu 8 of 8.1, Identification, Mapping and monitoring of the Fire prone areas containing of 20.0 hectares within the graduated area of National Greening Program.

Please be informed that the undersigned conducted Identification/delineation of fire prone area at Barangay New Quezon, Busuanga, Palawan, and hereunder are the following information gathered:

- 1. That the proposed dimension of fire line measured of 5m.x Width and 500mx length totaled of 2,500 square meters approximately,
- 2. That the same, said NGP project were established on 2017, and contracted by the Local Government Unit (Barangay Level) thru Memorandum of Agreement with Brgy. Captain Gaudencio S. Jagmis as Second Party,
- 3. The said NGP site had a program of activity to plant and maintained Cashew and Langka as main crops and kakawate as their Hedge row planted within the 76.0 hectares establish plantation thereat.
- 4. That sometimes on 2018, occurrence of fire raze the plantation from unknown source and destroy the plantation then by the same year also the LGU Contractor start to replant the area affected by the Fire.

Attached herewith is the GIS Map showing the fire prone area and Geotagged photos taken during the time of inspection of the area.
