
- 1. The office compound of DENR-CENRO Quezon, Palawan does not have yet a permanent perimeter fence;



ORDER

Records show that on August 25, 2020 at around 11:25 in the evening, at Sitio Reservation, Barangay Alfonso XIII, Quezon, Palawan, the composite team of CENRO-Quezon and PNP Maritime Quezon personnel apprehended fifty-five (55) pieces of lumber of Nato, Kalantas, and Siar species having an aggregate volume of 0.986 cubic meter (418.00 board feet), with an estimated fair market value of Php 14,630.00. Subject forest products had no claimant during the time it was apprehended and were hauled and brought to the DENR-CENRO Quezon, Palawan compound for safekeeping. A Seizure Receipt and Seizure Order, both dated September 01, 2020 were issued by Forester Ma. Teresa V. Ayson, Seizure Officer.
