Please be informed that PENRO Occidental Mindoro has established three (3) hectares arboretum on the year 2015, located at Sitio Igsuso, Barangay Tubili, Paluan, Occidental Mindoro, it was planted of different endemic species such as: batino, narra, mulawin, akleng parang, malaruhut, duhat, anilao, mambog, balinghasai, kalantas, alacaak, lanete, antipolo, kamagong, ipil, pagsahingin, and alim.

The latest ocular inspection of the arboretum was on July 8, 2021, since then no monitoring has been conducted. Be informed further that there is no fund allotted for the continuous maintenance and protection of the established arboretum. Geotagged photos and map are herein attached

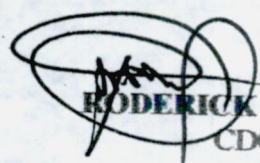
