Based on the attached Monkey Stock Inventory of Del Mundo Trading, a total 4,222 heads of Philippine Monkey (Macaca fascicularis) of which 2,923 are breeders (358 male and 2,565 female) and 1,299 growers (840 male and 459 female). Unfortunately, out of the said total, there were 18 casualties recorded for the 4th quarter.
