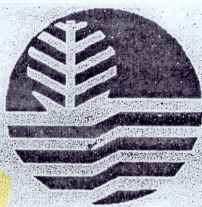



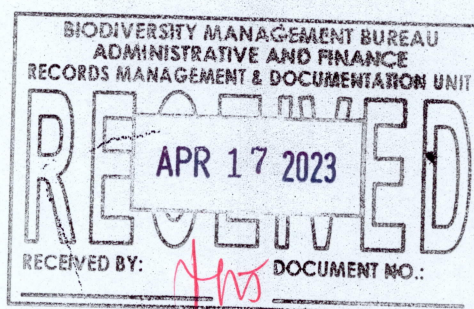

Respectfully forwarded is the Memorandum dated February 1, 2023 from OIC, PENRO Oriental Mindoro submitting the report of Administrator DMT Christian Brian V. Del Mundo dated January 13, 2023 and its enclosures regarding the above subject.

Based on the attached Monkey Stock Inventory of Del Mundo Trading, a total 4,222 heads of Philippine Monkey (*Macaca fascicularis*) of which 2,923 are breeders (358 male and 2,565 female) and 1,299 growers (840 male and 459 female). Unfortunately, out of the said total, there were 18 casualties recorded for the 4th quarter.

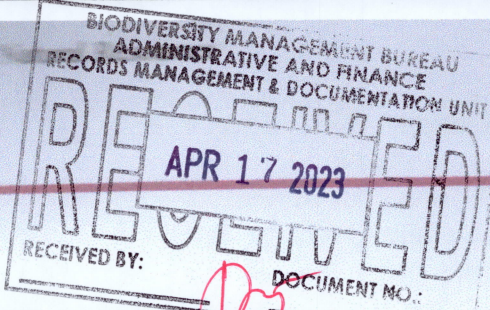
