GUIDELINES ON THE SEARCH FOR INTERNAL AUDIT SERVICE (IAS) WITH INNOVATIONS AND BEST PRACTICES IN INTERNAL AUDITING

I. BASIC POLICY

The AGIA aims to promote competence, integrity, professionalism and commitment in internal auditing works and practices and for this objective, it seeks to provide awards and incentives to recognize the exceptional performance, innovative ideas, ethical behavior, superior accomplishments and other efforts that contributed to transparency, accountability, good governance and responsiveness in the delivery of public service.

II. OBJECTIVE

To give due recognition and reward to government internal auditing units for innovations and best practices in internal auditing that promote significant improvement in operations.

III. SCOPE

The Search is open to all internal auditing units in the following sectors:

- National Government Agencies (NGAs)
- Government-Owned and Controlled Corporations (GOCCs) / Government Financial Institutions (GFIs)
- Local Government Units (LGUs)
- State Universities and Colleges (SUCs)

There shall be one (1) winner per sector.

IV. CRITERIA FOR QUALIFICATION

- 1. The participating NGA/GOCC/GFI/LGU/SUC must have a duly organized and fully operational IAS/IAU, i.e., with approved plantilla positions, that conforms to relevant DBM guidelines/issuances and other pertinent government rules and regulations.
- The concerned Head and at least three (3) staff of the IAS/IAU of any participating Agency must be in good standing and active members of AGIA as of the date of submission of application.
- 3. The submitted innovations / best practices must not have been previously submitted as an entry to other AGIA contests of the same nature.

V. CONTEST RULES

- An Agency may submit not more than two (2) major innovations / best practices in internal auditing that have significantly improved internal audit performance and contributed to overall Agency operations. The innovation / best practice must have been continuously implemented for at least six (6) months as of January 31, 2023;
- Entries must be accompanied by a duly accomplished Application Form (AGIA Search Form 1- Annex 1), together with all pertinent documents. Multiple entries must
