
Further, the team recommended for the actual easement delineation and demarcation along the coastal areas within the municipality to determine the exact measurement of the easement. Hence, fund allocation for the said demarcation shall be allocated. Accordingly, issuance of Notice to Vacate (NTV) to possible violators shall be of jurisdiction of NWRB as per verbal instruction of the Regional Executive Director.

As per instruction from the OIC-PENRO, the undersigned personnel conducted investigation on the area regarding the complaint against alleged construction site within salvage zone areain Oriental Mindoro from Mr. Allan Leuterio.

# I. FACTUAL BACKGROUND AND REFERENCES


- An email dated November 15, 2022 from Mr. Alan Leuterio was sent to the Office of the Secretary via email address <a href="mailto:osec@denr.gov.ph">osec@denr.gov.ph</a> and <a href="mailto:aksyonkalikasan@denr.gov.ph">aksyonkalikasan@denr.gov.ph</a> on November 10, 2022.
- Mr. Alan Leuterio allegedly complaint for the reconstruction of ripraps damaged by waves along coastal area using concrete materials which he saw in the video vlog of Kasister Merry in youtube, and he believes within the salvage zone area.
- ➤ USEC for Field Operations Luzon & Visayas and Environment, Atty. Juan Miguel T. Cuna, CESO I, referred the matter to DENR MIMAROPA Region as per Memorandum dated January 20, 2023 which was received on February 10, 2023.
- The OIC, Assistant Regional Director for Technical Services, Maximo C. Landrito, referred the same to PENRO Oriental Mindoro directing to conduct an immediate investigation in coordination with the parties concerned to determine the veracity of the complaint, as per memorandum dated February 20, 2023 duly received at PENRO on March 06, 2023.
- The said instruction / memorandum was then referred to the PENRO Regulation and Permitting Section Survey Unit headed by Engr. Elizabeth D. Moreno-Mesina dated March 8, 2023 and received on March 13, 2023.

### II. ACTIONS TAKEN

On March 22, 2023, the team proceeded with the LGU of Bulalacao to coordinate and verify the exact location of the vlogger involved in the complaint and the location of the shoreline being captured in the video. The team found out that the location of the shoreline being the subject of the complaint is in Barangay San Francisco, Bulalacao.

Then the team went to Barangay San Francisco and coordinated with the Barangay Officials and confirmed the whereabouts of Kasister Merry Vlogger (Merry B. Magcalayo). Barangay Concilor Reynaldo P. Zalde and Barangay Tanod Liezel R. Soriano of San Francisco who were the officer on duty in the Barangay that day, assisted the team in conducting site inspection.

The team discovered that the said shoreline has an existing concrete path way about 1-meter wide used as access road of all the residents residing in the beach front. During the

As per instruction from the OIC-PENRO, the undersigned personnel conducted investigation on the area regarding the complaint against alleged construction site within salvage zone are in Oriental Mindoro from Mr. Allan Leuterio.

# I. FACTUAL BACKGROUND AND REFERENCES

- An email dated November 15, 2022 from Mr. Alan Leuterio was sent to the Office of the Secretary via email address <a href="mailto:osec@denr.gov.ph">osec@denr.gov.ph</a> and <a href="mailto:aksyonkalikasan@denr.gov.ph">aksyonkalikasan@denr.gov.ph</a> on November 10, 2022.
- Mr. Alan Leuterio allegedly complaint for the reconstruction of ripraps damaged by waves along coastal area using concrete materials which he saw in the video vlog of Kasister Merry in youtube, and he believes within the salvage zone area.
- ➤ USEC for Field Operations Luzon & Visayas and Environment, Atty. Juan Miguel T. Cuna, CESO I, referred the matter to DENR MIMAROPA Region as per Memorandum dated January 20, 2023 which was received on February 10, 2023.
- The OIC, Assistant Regional Director for Technical Services, Maximo C. Landrito, referred the same to PENRO Oriental Mindoro directing to conduct an immediate investigation in coordination with the parties concerned to determine the veracity of the complaint, as per memorandum dated February 20, 2023 duly received at PENRO on March 06, 2023.
- ➤ The said instruction / memorandum was then referred to the PENRO Regulation and Permitting Section Survey Unit headed by Engr. Elizabeth D. Moreno-Mesina dated March 8, 2023 and received on March 13, 2023.

### II. ACTIONS TAKEN

On March 22, 2023, the team proceeded with the LGU of Bulalacao to coordinate and verify the exact location of the vlogger involved in the complaint and the location of the shoreline being captured in the video. The team found out that the location of the shoreline being the subject of the complaint is in Barangay San Francisco, Bulalacao.

Then the team went to Barangay San Francisco and coordinated with the Barangay Officials and confirmed the whereabouts of Kasister Merry Vlogger (Merry B. Magcalayo). Barangay Concilor Reynaldo P. Zalde and Barangay Tanod Liezel R. Soriano of San Francisco who were the officer on duty in the Barangay that day, assisted the team in conducting site inspection.

The team discovered that the said shoreline has an existing concrete path way about 1-meter wide used as access road of all the residents residing in the beach front. During the

typhoon that hit the province last quarter of year 2022, portions of the said path way was damaged due to heavy waves. According to the Barangay Secretary, Ms. Renalyn S. Panganiban, the Barangay already submitted Resolution and requested funds for the rehabilitation of said pathway (from Sitio Alimawan to Coro Coro) amounting to Php176,432.33, and still waiting for the approval and downloading of funds. More or less 20 households are inhabiting along the shoreline that will be benefited of the project. See attached copy of said resolution.

On the other hand, as per interview with Merry B. Magcalayo and his brother, Edralin B. Magcalayo, one of their subscribers donated for a fund for the reconstruction of the portion of the damaged pathwalk, and they vlogged it to show to the donor to where the money was spent.

### III. FINDINGS

Based on the Article 51 of PD 1067 or the Water Code of the Philippines, 20-meter legal easement shall be observed for public use considering that Barangay San Francisco is classified as rural barangay. As per inspection, most of the residential houses are built within the 20-meter easement zone.

Per information from some of the residents, years ago, the shoreline is far from the actual shoreline now which changes as time goes by. Per inerview, some residents have their title on the land they occupy, but others don't have title. According to the Barangay officials, residents along the shoreline were already warned not to reside thereat because they are the primary problem when typhoon comes to their locality.

# IV. RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that actual easement delineation and demarcation be done along the coastal areas within the municipality to exactly determine the measurement of easement. Residents that might violate onto the legal easment shall be issued with Notice to Vacate (NTV). Likewise, IEC campaign on different environmental laws shall also be done to be able for them (residents) to be familiarize on the different laws, rules and regualtions being implemented by DENR. Appropriate funds for these activities shall be requested and allocated.

Further, rehabilitation of the pathway probably of great help them to protect their property from erosion during heavy waves. The barangay is hereby advised to fast track the rehabilitation project to protect the land and the residents.

Barangay Officials be advised to strictly observed the strict issuance of permits for the construction of permanent structures within the 20-meter easement zone.
