CELEBRATION

World Wetlands Day is being celebrated every February 2 to raise global awareness about the vital role of wetlands for people and our planet. It marks the anniversary of the Convention on Wetlands which was adopted as an International Treaty in 1971. Presidential Proclamation No. 74 Series of 1999 also declares February 2 of every year as National Wetlands Day in recognition of their immense importance to the welfare of the Filipino people and the protection of global biodiversity. The theme for the 2023 World Wetlands Day is "Its time for Wetland Restoration". It highlights the urgent need to prioritize wetland restoration and the steps we need to take to revive and restore degraded wetlands. Please be informed that the Conservation and Development Section participated and conducted activities for the celebration of World Wetlands Day 2023.

The undersigned, PMF Rogelio G. Abison represented CENRO Puerto Princesa in the World Wetlands Day 2023 celebration held on February 2, 2023 at Puerto Princesa Subterranean River National Park (PPSRNP).

The PPSRNP World Wetlands Day 2023 celebration was spearheaded by the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) headed by PASu Elizabeth A. Maclang. The activity was participated and supported by the partners in conservation: USAID-SIBOL Project, Sabang Renewable Energy Corporation (SREC), Pilipinas Shell Foundation, Inc. (PSFI), DENR-CENRO Puerto Princesa and Sabang Mangrove Tour Guide Association. The activities includes opening program, lectures, mangrove planting and unveiling of Ramsar Marker. Students and teachers of Cabayugan National High School and staffs of FourPoints by Sheraton joined the said activity which was held at Sabang Mangrove area in Barangay Cabayugan, Puerto Princesa City.

During the opening program, the undersigned, PMF Abison delivered a message on behalf of OIC CENRO Pedro A. Velasco of which information on world wetlands day was shared as well as the importance of the wetlands and its resources.

After the program, lectures followed with the following topics discussed: Wetlands, Ramsar Sites and World Wetlands Day discussed by Ms. Yen Villarin of PPSRNP; Wetlands Restoration and Status of Mangrove Forest in PPSRNP by Mr. Nevong Puna; and Orientation on City Ordinance No. 993 and knowledge about the negative impacts of patronizing the use of plastic (single use plastic) and polystyrene materials by Mr. Edilberto Magpayo of TANDIKAN program of Pilipinas Shell Foundation, Inc. (PSFI).

The young generations of PPSRNP were encouraged to take the lead and become wetland champions in their own little way and to create ripple effect to the community.

PSFI distributed eco bags and water bottles to the Senior High School Students as souvenirs. T-Shirts and calendars were also provided to the winners of trivia questions in relation to World Wetlands Day. After the lectures, a boodle fight lunch was served and shared by the participants and organizers.

After lunch, all the participants joined the mangrove planting activity as part of the mangrove restoration program of Sabang Mangrove damaged by Typhoon Odette. The century old growth mangroves can be observed in the area. To end the activity, a closing remarks was delivered by PASu Elizabeth A. Maclang. The team then proceeded at the wharf and undertook simple unveiling of Ramsar Marker.

On February 6, 2023, the Section hosted the Monday Forum of CENRO Puerto Princesa. During the said activity, the undersigned, Sr. EMS Ma. Vivian O. Soriano discussed the information on wetlands: major types of wetlands; wildlife in wetlands; roles of wetlands; threat to wetlands and information on World Wetlands Day including Ramsar Sites in the Philippines to enhance awareness of the personnel.




