

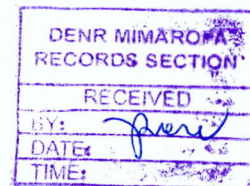

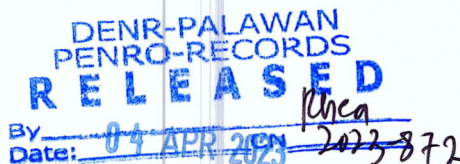

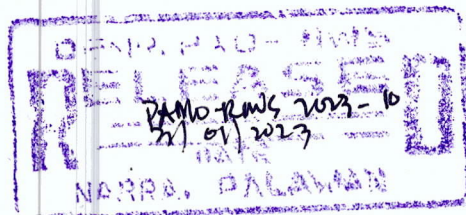

On or about 9:36 o'clock in the morning of February 24, 2023, the PAMO-RIWS staff in coordination with PNP Maritime personnel led by PSSg Louie Agustin stationed in Panacan Port, Narra, Palawan have rescued and released one (1) matured female Green Sea Turtle (*Chelonia mydas*).

Said turtle was found trapped in a fish corral at Bgy. Caguesan, Narra, Palawan. It was reported by a concerned citizen to PNP Maritime personnel. The incident was relayed to PAMO-RIWS for proper handling, tagging and release.

Based on inspection on the above sea turtle, there was no injury observed. The weight was approximately twenty (20) kilograms with twenty-four (24) inches length and twenty (20) inches width of carapace. Tagged number PH1439J was installed in the right portion of the fore flipper and was released successfully by the team at the shoreline area of Bgy. Panacan, Narra, Palawan.

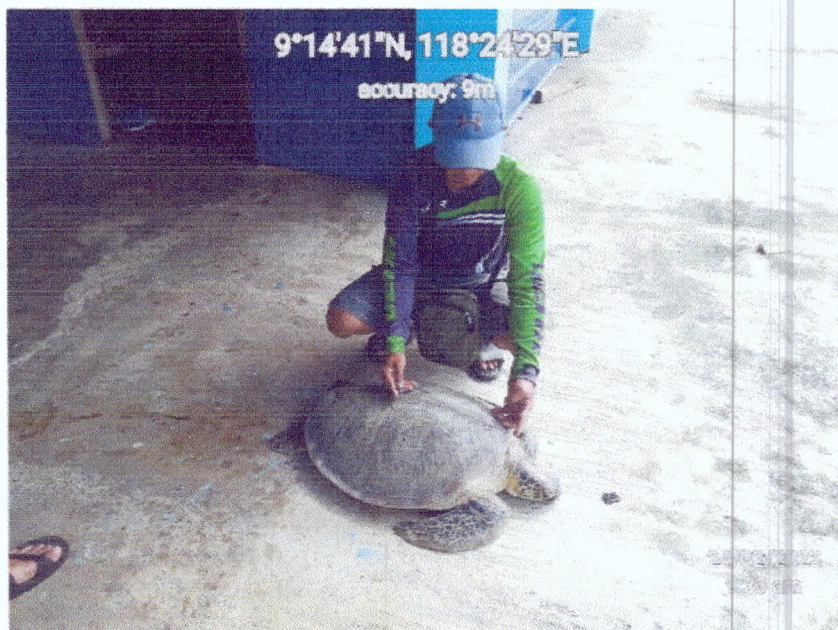

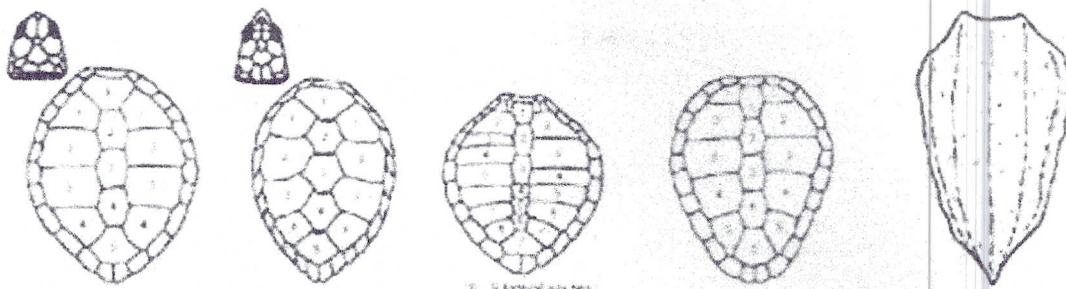

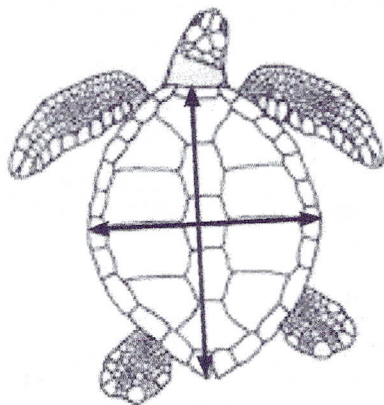
