


The CBFM area has total of 2,115 hectares bearing CBFM No. RIV- PAL-CBFM-2000-14 situated at Bgys of San Nicolas, Borac, Guadalupe and Bgy. Poblacion 6 all in Coron, Palawan. It was issued on December 8, 2000 and with expiration date on December 9, 2025.

Please be informed that CWBA-AMPC has an existing enterprise of water service and water refilling station and an on-going construction of their Cooperative Sari-sari Store at Brgy. San Nicolas.

The said PO was also granted a CBFM-CARP Project entitled Rattan Plantation Establishment for CY 2023 of about 20 hectares.

Further informed that no cutting/destruction and other illegal activities was observed within the CBFM area during the conduct of monitoring and assessment.



SUBJECT : **MONITORING /ASSESSMENT/EVALUATION REPORT OF COMMUNITY BASED FOREST MANAGEMENT (CBFM) AREA AWARDED TO CORON WATERSHED BENEFICIARIES ASSOCIATION LOCATED AT BGY'S OF POBLACION 6, GUADALUPE, BORAC AND SAN NICOLAS, CORON, PALAWAN**



This pertains to the monitoring/assessment/evaluation conducted on February 2, 2023 of the Community Based Forest Management (CBFM) area awarded to Coron Watershed Beneficiaries Association-Agroforestry Multi-Purpose Cooperative located at Brgys. Poblacion 6, Guadalupe, Borac and San Nicolas, Coron, Palawan. Please be informed of the following information; to wit:

- December 8, 2000 - Coron Watershed Beneficiaries Association-Agroforestry Multi-Purpose Cooperative was awarded Community Based Forest Management Agreement with CBFM No. R-IV-PAL-CBFM-2000-14 and with expiration date on December 9, 2025. The CBFM has total area of 2,115 hectares and falls within Unclassified Public Forest land.
- July 11, 2000. - The CBFM People's Organization was registered in Cooperative Development Authority.
- 2011-2012' - CWBA was granted by two CBFM-CARP project located at Bgy San Nicolas, Coron, Palawan (Phase-I) and Bgy. Borac, Coron, Palawan (Phase-II). The project entitled "Livelihood Assistance thru Agro-Forestry and Backyard Gardening. PO members were now enjoying the fruits of their labor especially banana and other agricultural cash crops.
- October 8, 2022 Forester Liezel N. Lim, Provincial ENRO and Forester Merlyn Blaza, CBFM Provincial Coordinator conducted evaluation and assessment of the CBFM area awarded to CWBA-AMPC for the search of CBFM Peoples Organization in the province of Palawan wherein CWBA-AMPC was one of the selected Peoples Organization.
- October 13-14, 2022 - Updating of the Community Resource Management Framework (CRMF)
- 2023-2024 - CWBA-AMPC was granted a CBFM-CARP project entitled

Rattan Plantation Development Project with an area of twenty (20) hectares. Fifteen (15) hectares for rattan, one (1) hectare for Black pepper and four (4) hectares for fruit bearing trees intercropped with agri-silvi crops.

The said PO is already establishing their Nursery and Bunkhouse located at So. Buang, Brgy. San Nicolas, Coron, Palawan

National Greening Program

The CWBA-AMPC Peoples Organization is one of our partner in the implementation of the NGP projects since 2011 to present. Some of the PO members with a total of sixteen (16) families were granted by planting contracts in CY 2021 through family approach. A total of 91 hectares ENGP regular and Bamboo plantation was established within the CBFM area particularly in So. Madlongon, Brgy. San Nicolas, Coron, Palawan and So. Mabentangen, Brgy. 6, Coron, Palawan respectively. The said plantation is already on its 3rd year.

With the support of the Lawin patrolling team, hired Forest Extension Officers and the PO members, the different National Greening Program projects are continuously maintained and protected, not only the NGP projects but the entire CBFM area as well.

Existing Enterprise

The CWBA-AMPC is continuously providing water service and water refilling station that caters mostly residents of Brgy. San Nicolas, Coron, Palawan and some residents of neighboring barangays.

The said PO is also planning to establish a Cooperative Sari-sari Store. They are already constructing their store building beside their refilling station.

Issues and Concern

- There are occupants within CBFM area which are not PO members.
- Occurrence of grassfire in the established plantation during dry season. The PO created Bantay Sunog to immediately respond and establish fire lines to protect the plantation




